KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF A DIRECTOR LIAISON

1. Provide an organizational strategic view and direction to volunteers through regular attendance at executive and committee meetings;
2. Affirm and oversee implementation of Board policies;
3. Understand and communicate the issues of the volunteer committees in Board and Board committee discussions;
4. Support cooperation and partnership of the volunteers and staff who share work objectives with the volunteer committees;
5. Provide mentorship and guidance to volunteer committee leaders as required;
6. Support volunteer strategy initiatives to provide best practices in committee governance, volunteer leadership, training, succession planning and resources, including the identification of future committee leaders;
7. Support and recognize the valuable and key work of the volunteers.
