For more than 100 years, the Calgary Stampede has showcased our community's western heritage, cultures and community spirit on the world stage. Those years are only possible because of the tireless work of thousands of dedicated Stampede volunteers and employees. This year, we looked at the Stampede's story through the lens of that community, drawing on the experiences of the team whose vast contributions help us create Stampede Park as a world-class gathering place for the community.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT & CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Dear Friends,

Our great city of Calgary and surrounding communities faced another year of tough economic challenges throughout 2016. The Calgary Stampede, as a year-round organization, has equally experienced the challenges facing our community and, when we all came together to celebrate during Stampede 2016, it rained almost every day. In fact, this was the wettest Stampede since 1927! But the bigger story about Stampede 2016 was the community spirit that prevailed as Stampede Park welcomed more guests who had never previously experienced the Stampede festival than ever before. And, the show went on with some of the biggest and best programming the Stampede has ever offered. The celebrations that took place over the 10 days are a testament to the resiliency and optimism that make our community great and remind us that we truly are Greatest Together. At the beginning of 2016, we launched a new, three-year strategic plan that positioned the Stampede's connection with the community as an overarching theme for all the objectives we will endeavour to fulfil. The Stampede's vision to be a world-class, year-round gathering place for the community reflects the resolve of the organization to support the prosperity of Calgary through the creation of new gathering spaces, such as the recently opened ENMAX Park and the soon-to-be completed Youth Campus.



We move forward with great expectations for 2017 and bold aspirations that include expanding the Stampede's BMO Convention Centre to position Calgary as a tier-one convention city and supporting economic diversity for the community. The Stampede's 2,300 volunteers and 300 employees will continue to work passionately, along with our many community partners toward bringing value to the city of Calgary now and into the future.

For the Stampede, the story of 2016 was in many ways about looking forward and looking outward at the community to better understand how the organization's foundation of western values supports a Stampede that is for everyone, both in our year-round activities as well as during the annual Stampede festival.

We are proud to share with you a number of the organization's key accomplishments in 2016:

Launching our new strategic plan

Our 2016-2018 Strategic Plan aims to achieve meaningful impacts through five strategic objectives. Here are those objectives and their respective outcomes:

- 1) Align with our community: The Stampede's brand values reflect the values of our community.
- 2) Connecting through our brand promise: Expanded urban and rural programming, including the annual Stampede and our year-round community celebrations, reflect our agricultural roots, western values and the cultural identity of Calgarians.
- 3) Supporting youth achievement in our community: Our core youth programs deliver sought-after learning experiences and engage our diverse communities.

- 4) Building our vision: ENMAX Park, TransAlta Performing Arts Studios, Calgary Arts Academy, BMO Amphitheatre, and Walton Hall are activated through our community engagement program as new gathering spaces on Stampede Park. The community is engaged in the prospect of future Stampede Park developments.
- 5) Building our team: Our community, our volunteers and our employees recognize the Stampede as a unified organization that delivers enriched value through enhanced engagement, transparency, trust and professionalism.

We are pleased to say we've made great strides throughout 2016 toward all five of these objectives—and you'll see many examples of that progress throughout this report.

Park Development

We were thrilled to open our new ENMAX Park in June this year. The park brings together history, art, Indigenous culture and green space. During the year, ENMAX Park will be open to the public as a place to gather and be close to nature in the inner city.

We unveiled the Rainbow Trout public art instalment at Calgary Foundation Crossing near the MacDonald Avenue entrance to ENMAX Park, a tribute to the river's ecology. Visitors can explore Cenovus Legacy Trail, which traces the history of the local area. The new Sweetgrass Lodge facility opened and was named by the Treaty 7 tipi owners of Indian Village—braided sweetgrass is sacred in Indigenous cultures and represents perseverance.

After years of planning, it was exciting to see Indian Village, presented by Penn West, in its new location in ENMAX Park.

We also hosted our first Community Fall Fair in the park in October, welcoming more than 1,500 guests for pumpkin spice pancakes, wagon rides, pumpkin decorating and many more fun fall activities.

We began working with city stakeholders on the proposed expansion of the BMO Centre, which will position Calgary as a tier-one convention city and will bring economic diversity to the community and southern Alberta. We are working with all three levels of government on funding models for the \$500 million expansion, which will result in 535,500 square feet of total rentable space and 177,000 square feet of pre-function space for a total building footprint of just under one million square feet. The projected economic impacts of the expansion are as follows:

- Construction of the expanded BMO Centre is expected to generate \$497 million for Canada, with \$402 million aiding Alberta alone.
- The construction phase will support 1,862 direct full-year jobs in Alberta, with over \$155 million in wages and salaries for Alberta workers.
- Close to \$70 million in direct taxes will be paid to all three levels of government during construction.

Annual economic impacts of the BMO Centre post expansion include:

- \$267 million to Canada's GDP, including \$223 million for Alberta.
- 1,757 direct full-time jobs, of which 1,580 will be retained in Calgary.
- 1,297 additional jobs supported by indirect and induced spending.
- Direct wages of \$79 million for the BMO Centre and other front-line businesses.
- More than \$44 million in direct taxes to three levels of government.

We also partnered with the Calgary Municipal Land Corporation and look forward to working with them on advancing Calgary's Culture and Entertainment District—comprised of Stampede Park, East Village and Beltline.

Youth Development

We made significant progress on the Youth Campus development on Stampede Park. The TransAlta Performing Arts Studios facility was completed in December 2016 and welcomed students in January 2017. This Youth Campus facility will provide much needed rehearsal space the Calgary Stampede Foundation's youth performing arts programs, Stampede Showband and The Young Canadians School of Performing Arts.

Other Youth Campus developments that are underway include Calgary Arts Academy, which began construction in 2016, as well as the BMO Amphitheatre and Walton Hall, which will both be completed in 2017.

The past year we continued to support youth achievement in our community through the development of programs and events that offer youth immersive educational experiences outside the traditional classroom. We believe this type of hands-on learning will connect the next generation with our vibrant history and foster forward-thinking about sustainability in agriculture and the prosperity of our community.

In addition to the Stampede's existing youth programs, we were pleased to launch the inaugural Farm Safety Day with the support of AltaLink. In May, more than 650 students from Calgary and southern Alberta's agriculture communities participated in this event to learn about best practices in farm safety.

With the generous support of Agrium, Journey 2050 continues to receive high praise from educators regarding the impact of the program. Grades 7 to 12 students are challenged through the program to think about how we will sustainably feed the world in 2050, when there are nine billion people on the planet.

Now in its third year, the OH Ranch Education Program provides students the chance to learn about life on a working ranch along with environmental sustainability in the ranching industry and the history of ranching in southern Alberta.

Stampede time

Welcoming more than one million guests during the wettest Stampede we can remember—it's a Stampede thing!

Yes, we had the rainiest Stampede since 1927, but it was a great one too. As a nod to the Year of Music in Calgary, we kicked off our celebrations with two great Calgarian musicians: Paul Brandt and Jann Arden, affectionately known as PB&J. Paul and Jann served as the official Parade Marshals of Stampede 2016.

Premier Rachel Notley and Mayor Naheed Nenshi joined the Parade Marshals, Stampede Royalty and the Calgary Stampede board of directors to lead the opening day Parade.

The historic official opening of Indian Village in ENMAX Park was attended by dignitaries from all three levels of government and enjoyed by guests from the community and around the world.

We had an outstanding visit from Prime Minster Justin Trudeau and the federal Minister of Agriculture, the Honourable Lawrence MacAulay, who got to see first-hand the great work Stampede does toward strengthening urban and rural connections.

New programming popped up around Stampede Park, including the Dog Bowl, Adventure Park and the International Pavilion.

New promotions brought enthusiastic new audiences and a record attendance on our final Sunday. In light of the rainy weather, the many indoor activities and programs offered during Stampede were showcased this year and provided new experiences for many returning guests of the Stampede.

We are looking forward in 2017 to seeing and hearing from you—our community—who make the Calgary Stampede and everything we do possible. As we said: We're Greatest Together.

Lisette Marion is a project coordinator with the Agriculture department. In her four years with the Calgary Stampede, she has enjoyed being part of the creation of events such as Farm Safety Day, as well as playing a role in the opening of the Agrium Western Event Centre. Lisette loves meeting new people and experiencing new things, both at the Stampede and in her travels around the world.

With the generous support of AltaLink, the Calgary Stampede was excited to host our first Farm Safety Day on Thursday, May 26. The event focused on helping more than 650 rural youth learn and identify the risks around them on the farm and how to keep themselves safe.

Dramatic demonstrations and hands-on learning educated the kids on equipment safety, livestock safety, working with electricity, distracted driving, ATVing, first aid and more. Students saw the powerful impact of accidents with a rollover simulator, as well as a station that showed just how dangerous it can be to get your clothing caught on a common piece of farm machinery—a power takeoff shaft.

Farm Safety Day delivers on our brand promise to create expanded urban and rural programming and supports youth achievement in our community.

"Kids usually don't know about these things and adults usually learn from experience, so it's good for kids to learn at an earlier age just so they can prevent accidents," said one student.

The Agriculture team, employees in partnership with Stampede volunteers, brought this event together. We worked with several community partners, including Ag for Life, Cervus Equipment, TransCanada Corporation, Calgary Police Department, Calgary Fire Department and Syngenta.

When we created Farm Safety Day, we wanted to provide young people with a learning experience they could apply to their real lives. Farm Safety Day delivers on our brand promise to create expanded urban and rural programming and supports youth achievement in our community. The Stampede is pleased to inspire and educate the next generation's agriculture leaders.

Mike Piper has been a Chuckwagon committee volunteer for more than 15 years. Born and raised in Calgary, Mike has been around wagons most of his life—never missing a show. He has grown to truly value the relationships with the great group of volunteers, employees and athletes (both human and equine), as

well as the ability to learn about the sport and the lifestyle and commitment of the families involved. After working in the film industry for a number of years, Mike moved into the automotive industry. He is currently the regional director of CARSTAR for Western Canada, where he was recently announced Employee of the Year for CARSTAR and Driven Brands.

The Calgary Stampede strives to be a leader in animal care practices and continues to look for improvements in safety measures. For example, Grandstand patrons enjoying the 2016 GMC Rangeland Derby may not have noticed the rule changes that went into effect this year, but these subtle changes will support the promotion and long-term sustainability of the sport of chuckwagon racing.

In 2016, we moved from a qualification process (based on the previous year's results) to a driver invitation process. The Calgary Stampede driver invitation process is based upon the driver's safety record, performance and sportsmanship. Each of these three factors is carefully considered based on the drivers' experience within their respective associations throughout the season, as well as at past Calgary Stampedes. Winning an association title the previous year no longer guarantees any driver a barrel position on the opening night of racing in Calgary. Only the safest and the best drivers will be given an opportunity to participate in the GMC Rangeland Derby.

Perhaps only the most devoted fans of the sport noticed the changes to our barrel placement. We slightly repositioned the barrels to give drivers more space as they make their figure eight, and clearer lanes as they exit out of the Infield and begin thundering around the track. The new placement is aimed at reducing the potential for out-of-lane infractions and wagon contact.

We also carried out magnetic particle inspections on 38 wagon poles (36 race wagons and two demonstration wagons). The inspections found a few very minor flaws. The flawed poles were repaired and re-inspected prior to racing.

Lastly, leading up to the 2016 Calgary Stampede, the track was rebuilt and repacked along the rail in an effort to provide a safer running surface for our horses, wagons, drivers and outriders. The significance of this change was made even more evident by how well the track held up against a never-ending volume of rain every day.

All of these changes, while seemingly independent of one another, contributed to the 94th Calgary Stampede chuckwagon races running as safe as possible. Credit must also be given to our 36 drivers. It's because of them that we're able to provide the safest possible racing while preserving the unique experience that begins when the horn sounds nightly at 8 p.m. for 10 exciting nights of the GMC Rangeland Derby.

RETIRING A CHAMPION: L-40 LYNX MOUNTAIN

A remarkable horse heads to the Calgary Stampede Ranch after 10 years of bucking

Tyler Kraft is the manager of the Calgary Stampede Ranch. A former rodeo competitor, Tyler now spends his days caring for the close to 600 horses at the ranch near Hanna, Alberta. Through the Stampede's Born to Buck program, he is able to use his expertise in the sport and his passion for the horses to build the next generation of equine superstars.

Lynx Mountain is a horse that cowboys dream of having their name drawn beside on the rodeo program. She gave a consistent performance each crack of the gate, always giving the judges what they wanted to see. Lynx had a remarkable career; she was selected nine times to the National Finals Rodeo and 10 times to the Canadian Finals Rodeo, consecutively. In 2009, she was voted the 2009 saddle bronc horse of Canada. The decision to retire Lynx was not an easy one. For the past 10 years, she has spent her winters bucking in Texas; the summers she bucked in places like Ponoka, Pendleton and, of course, the Calgary Stampede. While out on the road, the big stout black mare was one of the kingpins, but a considerate kingpin. She gave every other horse a fair warning by pinning her ears back, letting them know she got the first bite of morning oats. Lynx had her friends on the road; she liked to travel and eat beside Gross Beetle, Fearless Warrior and Muffled Cries. When she did go out on the road without some of her best friends, she was quick to get reacquainted with them out in the pasture, back at the Calgary Stampede Ranch.

One of the most honourable attributes about Lynx is that she only got stronger with age. Six of her eight 90 point rides came in when she was 10 years and older. Every quality she possesses is what we look for in a bucking horse. The future for her as a brood mare on the Stampede Ranch is going to be just as exciting as watching her buck in the arena. Today, she is pregnant by a world champion saddle bronc "Lunatic Fringe." We can expect to meet Lynx's little one in mid-april of 2017.



Brian has been a volunteer with the Calgary Stampede since 1989. He originally started with the Promotion committee and served as subcommittee chair with the Mobile Stage before becoming chair of the Promotion committee in 2008-2009. Brian has also been part of

the Nominating & Shareholder Relations committee and is currently a member of the Community Projects & Development committee.

During my time as chair of the Promotion committee, former president Mike Casey and I sat down to discuss how we could build a better relationship between the Stampede and the citizens of Calgary and surrounding communities. I wanted to take a more proactive approach to enhance this relationship by going out and identifying opportunities rather than waiting for a community to ask us to be part of their event. Last year at a Community Projects & Development committee meeting, I presented an idea called Pop Up Neighbours.

Pop Up Neighbours is a concept that builds on the Calgary Stampede brand value of commitment to community. It's about being neighbourly and welcoming, and not about being the best in Calgary, but the best FOR Calgary.

In 2016, the first year of the program, we participated in three events: the Veterans Food Bank Hamper Program, the City of Calgary River Cleanup and City of Calgary Senior Services – Paint the Town. These events were a resounding success, both in being able to help a local organization as well as interacting with community members and identifying new opportunities.

The River Cleanup involvement was truly appreciated by the Ramsay/ Inglewood communities, and it gave our volunteers civic pride to collect a pile of trash and help keep the river clean.

The City of Calgary Senior Services department was ecstatic that we chose to help them as they had seen a drop in the number of volunteer companies/organizations since the economy had changed. The woman whose property we painted could not say thank you enough for what we had done with her house; you could see how proud she was of the property. Her husband had passed away five years ago and there had been very little done for improvements to the property since.

We wore our cowboy hats at these events, and many community members stopped to ask what we were doing there. We had the opportunity to talk with community members about the Stampede and how we could work together.

This is a new project initiative for all Calgary Stampede volunteers, and we encourage every volunteer to look for opportunities to better their community. The ultimate goal is to have every committee find its own Pop Up Neighbour community event and execute at least one event each year.

Vanessa Stiffarm is from the Kainai Nation of southern Alberta. She grew up in her Blackfoot traditional ways and travelled Canada and the United States dancing at Pow Wows. She is currently attending school to become a pediatrician and was the 2016 Calgary Stampede Indian Princess, representing the Calgary Stampede and the five tribes of Treaty 7.

This year, the Calgary Stampede partnered with the University of Calgary on its inaugural Campfire Chat. The event took place on St. Patrick's Island on National Aboriginal Day–Tuesday, June 21, 2016.

A triple tipi raising and tipi painting ceremony took place during the day. In the evening, 150 people gathered around the campfire on the rise to see me perform a jingle dance and to hear Reg Crowshoe, former chief of the Piikani First Nation, speak.

As the Calgary Stampede Indian Princess, I shared my story of growing up on the Pow Wow Circuit. My dad is a singer and my mom is a Jingle Dress Dancer, like I am today. They both taught me the respect and dedication it takes to be a dancer.

Reg Crowshoe spoke to his experience growing up in the residential school system, where he was told he could not speak his language or practise his cultural traditions of dance and ceremony. Storytelling, he explained, is vital to his culture.

"I'm grateful today," he said at the event. "It's so important that we facilitate a venue so that our young people can come and take pride in their culture, and their language, and share as much knowledge as they can with others. When we're looking at moving ahead, we need to step up and take responsibility as Canadians to make a partnership that's going to work."

I was very honoured to be part of the Campfire Chat. My goal as Indian Princess was to share and educate others about my culture—and this event gave me the opportunity to do just that with my fellow Calgarians. Not many people know the history of First Nations people. This event gave people the opportunity to listen and ask questions in a safe, judgment-free environment.

He replied, "I have walked among the dead in the Canadian War Cemetery in Belgium where the fallen Canadian soldiers are buried. That was my first time on Canadian soil; you earned it."

I did not say another word. I couldn't, as the tears were coming down my face. We got up to the International Room and I shook their hands very firmly. They knew I had been emotional and proud. I told them safe travels and to please return again to the Stampede and Canada.

THE HARD-WORKING FARMERS OF DAIRY CLASSIC

This spring was the first year I got to help out with the Dairy Classic event. It was an eye-opener for me. Every Agriculture (Ag) event is different and has many small details to keep the animals healthy, and that are also very specific depending on the type of event. A dairy event, for example, is completely different from a team roping event or a horse jumping event, even though they are all in the same class of events – Agriculture.

I had no idea how hard the dairy industry works and how much detail and thought goes into producing our dairy products each day.

Students were given the knowledge of making drums during one of their mornings at Stampede School and they made plans to breathe life into them at the Blackfoot marker on Nose Hill. As a class, they wanted to honour and celebrate the lives of children impacted by the residential school system.

The day came to head to Nose Hill and the weather was unco-operative, so the students came to Stampede Park and we had the celebration here. Students and parent volunteers played their drums while Nii'danamska sang traditional songs. He shared with us the tradition of breathing life into the drums, which has to be done to honour and give new life to the animal who gave its hide to make the drums. He told us that the sound the drum makes represents the heartbeat of the animal living again.

Students were touched by this unique experience that allowed them to gain traditional Blackfoot knowledge and participate in an important ceremony.




