Through investing in youth and agricultural programs, providing world-class event facilities and offering a unique western experience for the world to enjoy, the Stampede has made positive impacts on communities across southern Alberta.

At the root of the Calgary Stampede brand are the core values of western hospitality, integrity, pride of place and commitment to the community. These values connect us to our past, to the present and to our future.

PURPOSE AND VISION

Since the launch of the Calgary Stampede 2013-2015 Strategic Plan three years ago, as well as a renewed purpose and vision in 2014, the Stampede has dedicated resources to become a year-round, world-class gathering place for the community. There are many facets to our vision, including our commitment to animal care, building stronger urban and rural connections, engaging Calgarians in their own backyards and supporting Stampede volunteers and employees to ride for the brand.

The Stampede's purpose is "to preserve and celebrate our western heritage, cultures and community spirit."

Our enhanced purpose and vision reflect the strategic direction of our organization and its supporters, in addition to best demonstrating our commitment to western heritage and respect for other traditions, such as those of our Treaty 7 partners and those of new Albertans.

Our revised vision also makes the connection with community explicit: "to create a world-class, year-round gathering place for the community." The good work our volunteers and employees do is aimed at providing benefits for the community, now and into the future.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT AND CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE CEO

Dear Friends,

Back in the 1980s, we both started with the Calgary Stampede – one as a volunteer and the other as an employee. We were both drawn to this organization because of its importance to and widespread support it receives from the residents of Calgary and southern Alberta and its strong and unique community connection.

Some thirty years later, we take even greater pride in now having the opportunity to lead an organization that values making a difference in our community.

Looking back over this past year, we are proud that the Stampede continued to deliver exceptional Stampede-time experiences and diverse year-round programming due to the efforts of our hard working and amazing employees and volunteers. We are both looking forward to 2016, which we expect to be challenging, but also still full of new opportunities to grow the Stampede brand.

TRANSITION AND CONTINUITY

As we stepped into our respective roles in March of 2015, we were thankful for the strong foundation built by our predecessors, Bob Thompson, who completed his two year role as president & chairman of the board, and Vern Kimball, who retired after 12 years as CEO.

There is no question, however, that 2015 was a year where we faced serious economic challenges, the impact of which will likely continue to be felt in Alberta for years to come. We are pleased to say that we

recognized and acted early to take cost cutting steps, without impacting our Stampede guest experience. We believe that we have reset the financial position of our organization – ensuring the flexibility to appropriately respond and react to further economic declines or if a rebound occurs earlier than is generally expected.

One thing we can assure you of is that even if further spending cuts become necessary, you will not notice them at Stampede. Our goal, as always is to put on at least the same if not better in quality Rodeo, Chuckwagon Races, Grandstand Show, Coca Cola Stage and general fair that will equal or exceed last years' events and to provide numerous new and first time events. We will not cut corners and risk becoming the same old thing - neither of us can or would settle for that because none of our volunteers or employees will settle for that either.

We are very thankful for the dedication, passion and hard work of countless supporters, volunteers and employees. Without you, the difficult years would become impossible; with you anything and everything seems achievable as we truly are "Greatest Together."

2015 HIGHLIGHTS

I. Capital Campaign

The Calgary Stampede Foundation's **We're Greatest Together** capital campaign wrapped up in July – together we raised \$131,236,580 to bring our vision of a year-round gathering place for the community to reality.

As a result of **We're Greatest Together**:

- The Agrium Western Event Centre is the new heart and home of year-round western events and agricultural education on Stampede Park, including the leading-edge Journey 2050, an experiential learning program that teaches students about food sustainability.
- The Agrium Centre also provides a state-of-the-art facility for national and international equine competitions, rodeos, agricultural exhibitions and trade shows.
- ENMAX Park, which we are excited to open in June 2016, is a new space that will bring together western history, aboriginal culture and the environment. It will be a year-round gathering place where Calgarians and visitors from all around the world can come for recreation, learning and celebration.
- The new Youth Campus will be a unique place for our community. Once open, Youth Campus will house Stampede School, The Young Canadians School of Performing Arts and the Calgary Stampede Showband, as well as the public charter school, Calgary Arts Academy, Calgary Opera, and more than 160 local community organizations.
- Youth Campus will allow for aspiring youths and industry professionals, several opportunities to share physical and knowledge resources, in order to create Calgary's newest arts and culture hub.



We are honoured by the support of government, numerous philanthropists, corporate Calgary, Stampede volunteers and Stampede employees, and many others who committed to preserving and promoting the Stampede's legacy. Through our facilities we are connecting the next generation of Calgarians to the Stampede's values and spirit of what makes Calgary great.

2. 2015 Stampede

Though there was a small decline in attendance during the 2015 Stampede, overall the financial aspects of the Stampede were very positive – proving that even in a cooling economy our community loves to celebrate Stampede – gathering and creating special memories.

Kaillie Humphries, two-time Olympic bobsled champion and Lou Marsh Award recipient, kicked off The Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth as presiding Parade Marshal. This born-and-raised Calgarian is an international role model and was one of our most well-received Parade Marshals. More than 250,000 parade watchers lined the streets of downtown Calgary to help kick-off Stampede 2015.

The 2015 TransAlta Grandstand Show: Canadian Classic received rave reviews for the production and performances but it was our special guests who came out and stole our hearts. For 10 nights, live in front of an audience of 20,000 people, 13 immigrant families joined The Young Canadians of the Calgary Stampede onstage to take their citizenship oath and were celebrated in spectacular Stampede style. It was an honour to witness these touching and moving ceremonies.

3. Youth Development

The Calgary Stampede and Calgary Stampede Foundation's year-round youth and education programming touched the lives of thousands of young people from across southern Alberta. From learning about agriculture, animals and our province's great history, to receiving exceptional performing arts training, our commitment to the personal and professional development of youth is a legacy of which we are all proud.

The numbers from 2015 speak volumes about the Stampede's commitment to youth programming and education:

- 148 members enrolled in The Young Canadians School of Performing Arts (100 were between 11-18 years of age, 48 juniors between seven to 11 years of age).
- 124 members (ages 15-21) are in the Calgary Stampede Showband.

- 4,500 students from across 50 Calgary schools throughout the year participated in Journey 2050 to learn about food sustainability.
- Almost 900 students from 21 Calgary Board of Education and six Calgary Catholic School Division classes attended Stampede School.
- More than 700 students from Calgary and southern Alberta schools visited the Calgary Stampede OH Ranch to learn about best practices in animal care, land and ecosystem management.
- 40,000 students took part in our annual five-day Aggie Days program.

4. Stampede Milestones

Our success is thanks to our community, generous supporters, guests, volunteers, employees and partners. Through the years we have accomplished so much together and we are proud to see so many initiatives celebrate anniversaries in 2015. A few notable milestones are:

- The Stampede's mascot, Harry the Horse turned 30. To celebrate, a birthday bash was thrown in his honour on Canada Day at Olympic Plaza.
- The 30th Aggie Days, presented by Encana, hosted more than 40,000 youth in April to participate in agriculture education.
- The Stampede and the Indian Village, presented by Penn West, were proud to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Calgary Stampede Indian Princess program. To mark this momentous occasion, Calgary Stampede Indian Princess alumni took part in both year-round and Stampede-time activities.
- The Stampede Talent Search competition was originally created to provide free, Stampede Park entertainment and showcase local youth talent. The competition was so successful that the Stampede Talent Search program became a Stampede staple. After 35 years of amazing performances, the 2015 Talent Search Champion, Christian Hudson, helped to make the year even more memorable by donating his \$10,000 cash winnings to the Calgary Drop-In and Rehab Centre.
- For 25 years the Calgary Stampede Farm Equipment committee has been preserving our agriculture heritage for young and old by bringing vintage tractors and equipment back to life and showcasing them to the public during Stampede time.

WHAT'S NEXT

2016-2018 Strategic Plan

Three years ago, our 2013-2015 Strategic Plan was set into motion to focus on three fundamental areas: delivering exceptional experiences that entertain, educate and engage visitors; building inspired spaces to bring our community together to celebrate; and working to further energize the brand that has come to define our city. We are both pleased with the progress the Stampede made in supporting the 2013-2015 Strategic Plan during the last three years.

Over the course of 2015, the board and management team worked together to recalibrate our organization's objectives going forward. The outcome is a new 2016-2018 Strategic Plan that will guide the Calgary Stampede for the next three years. The plan makes the connection to our community explicit and clearly articulates the work we must continue in order to provide a benefit to the community now and into the future.

The following five strategies will guide our board's decision making over the next three years and we expect that focusing on these strategies will bring our common vision and purpose for the organization to life.

- Aligning with our community;
- Connecting through our brand promise;
- Supporting youth achievement in our community;
- Building our vision; and
- Building our team.

Our supporters wear many hats - long-time shareholders and young members of the Alberta agriculture industry; year-round volunteers and first-time guests; full-time employees and annual recruits for Stampede; well-known community partners and those we have yet to meet.

JULY 2015 STAMPEDE TIME HIGHLIGHTS

By the time our entrances closed on the final Sunday of Stampede, 1.2 million people had made their way through the turnstiles to enjoy The Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth.

It was clear from the hundreds of local pancake breakfasts and festive window displays all over the city: 2015 was another year that just couldn't be missed.

Those who gathered at this year's Stampede saw some of their annual favourites as well as these exciting additions:

- Triple B – BBQ, Bulls and Beer – was back with an expanded venue area and redesigned space.
- Calgary's best country music party was bigger, sunnier and later with Nashville North's large new patio and extended hours.
- The appetite for Stampede Midway sensations grows larger each year! A food vendor selling \$100 Dragon Dogs, a hot dog infused with cognac and topped with Kobe beef, lobster and truffles, sold out on the second day of Stampede.
- New to the BMO Marketplace this year were local Etsy designers.
- Guests also enjoyed visits to Little Ray's Reptile Zoo, a 4,000 sq. ft. reptile exhibit, and Nature's Ninjas, a scientific education and animal awareness program.

The Midway food item that took everyone by surprise was the \$100 Dragon Dog, which featured a Louis XVII cognac infused bratwurst, lobster and truffles. This decadent delight sold out by the second day of Stampede!

The 2015 Parade Marshal Kaillie Humphries, proudly led 121 entries, including 13 bands, 32 floats and more than 700 horses across the 4.5 km Parade route.

For the eighth year in a row, the Calgary Stampede's charity of choice for unwanted Midway prizes was HART International. An estimated 5,000 stuffies and prizes were donated by generous guests to Moldovan and Ukrainian children in need.

Stampede Park hosted many animal guests in July, including 629 chuckwagon horses and 410 bucking horses and bulls that competed during the Calgary Stampede Rodeo. INDIAN VILLAGE CELEBRATES 40 YEARS OF MEMORIES

For more than 100 years, Indian Village has been an essential part of the Stampede. Tipi Owners, sponsors, volunteers and employees work hard to make Indian Village engaging and memorable for visitors and guests.

Members of the Treaty 7 First Nations – Siksika, Kainai, Piikani, TsuuT’ina and Stoney Nakoda – have participated in the Calgary Stampede since 1912. That year, some First Nations camped on the exhibition grounds, creating the first Indian Village. For more than 100 years, Indian Village has been an essential part of the Stampede. Tipi owners, sponsors, volunteers and employees work hard to make Indian Village engaging and memorable for visitors and guests.

On July 12, 2015, the Stampede family, community members and guests from around the world observed the final Indian Village closing ceremony on the south side of Stampede Park. Our tipi owners led a spiritual moving camp ceremony to close Indian Village at the south end and prepare for the 2016 opening next Stampede.

In 2016, Indian Village will move to ENMAX Park located on the east side of the Elbow River. This site has two-and-a-half times more green space than the previous. Here’s a brief look at the history of Indian Village at the Calgary Stampede Park.

1912 AND 1923

Exhibition Grounds



First Nations of Treaty 7 have always been an important part of the Calgary Stampede, beginning when Guy Weadick invited them to camp at the Stampede in 1912. Weadick’s invitation played an important role in preserving and promoting the traditions of the Treaty 7 First Nations. Laws limiting cultural practices meant that the Stampede was one of the few places that First Nations traditions could be openly practiced among the tribes.

1923 - 1973

Sun Tree park



The first organized Indian Village was established at Sun Tree Park, near the northwest corner of Stampede Park (approximately where the Coca-Cola Stage now stands).

1974 - 2015

South end of Stampede Park



Indian Village moved to the south end of the grounds; 25th Avenue near Erlton entrance.

2016

ENMAX Park



The 14-acre urban green space is located on the east side of the Elbow River, behind the Scotiabank Saddledome. It will be home to new public art pieces as well as Indian Village and the new Penn West Stage.

CO-CREATING GATHERING SPACES

In 2012, we imagined new entertainment, retail, education and celebration experiences contributing to building a world-class, year-round gathering place for the community on Stampede Park. To achieve the goals set out in the Strategic Plan, the Stampede committed to strengthen relationships with community members and actively worked to forge deeper relationships with other non-profit organizations.

One example of this commitment happened in March 2015, when we proudly announced a trailblazing partnership with the Calgary Opera as part of the Calgary Stampede Youth Campus. 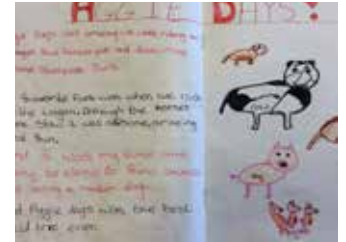
STRENGTHEN AND BUILD URBAN AND RURAL CONNECTIONS

As a recognized leader in creating urban and rural connections in our community, the Stampede was proud to celebrate two exciting milestones this year. Aggie Days, an award-winning program, celebrated agriculture education for the 30th time. Presented by Encana, Aggie Days hosted more than 40,000 youth from Wednesday, April 8 to Sunday, April 14. In August, the Stampede participated in Alberta Open Farm Days for the first time and the Calgary Stampede OH Ranch welcomed more than 500 visitors.

AGGIE DAYS CELEBRATES AGRICULTURE EDUCATION FOR THE 30TH TIME

The first Aggie Days program was created for school children to experience agriculture up-close and learn where their food comes from. Aggie Days took place in a small part of the Agriculture Barns and featured a few exhibits and animals, mainly dairy cattle. The first year Aggie Days opened to the public on a Saturday, the volunteers worked hard to promote their program by distributing small posters all over Calgary and phoning radio stations and newspapers to get the message out. The attendance that year was about 400 people, including families, friends and neighbours of the committee... a remarkable difference in 2015 as Aggie Days saw more than 30,000 guests attend on the public weekend days!

Throughout the many expansions, moves and promotions of the Aggie Days program, there is one aspect that has not changed. From the beginning, the commitment and dedication of Stampede volunteers and exhibitors remained unparalleled. They all believed in the necessity of teaching youth about the importance of agriculture in our everyday lives. In Alberta, we are fortunate to have great farmers who grow crops and raise livestock so that we can all eat, and it is essential that students understand this process.

CALGARY STAMPEDE OH RANCH

OH Ranch allows the Calgary Stampede to connect with the agriculture industry and ranching communities in new and meaningful ways as the organization embarks upon being an active producer for the first time in its history. The OH Ranch opens a new chapter for the Calgary Stampede. It brings the organization closer to Alberta's agricultural roots.

OH Ranch follows three guiding principles:

- Preserve the western authenticity of the working OH Ranch.
- Preserve, protect and enhance the natural environment.
- Engage rural and urban communities with meaningful experiences, including an educational program offered to regional schools.

OH RANCH OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

On Sunday, August 23, the Calgary Stampede OH Ranch participated in the third annual Alberta Open Farm Days, a province-wide event that provides an opportunity for urban and rural Albertans to visit local farms and ranches where they discovered the importance of agriculture in the world.

The historic OH Ranch, an authentic working cattle ranch, provided an incredible setting for Alberta Open Farm Days visitors to learn about Alberta's heritage and unique identity. For one day only, the public was welcomed to participate in guided tours of the ranch to learn about how traditional herd management techniques, such as cattle grazing and grazing rotation, are key for both land preservation and management.

Guests also had the opportunity to explore the historic Ings cabin, visit the North West Mounted Police outpost and participate in hands-on western and ranch-themed activities.

Guests from around the world, as well as neighbours from the communities of Longview, High River, Okotoks and Turner Valley, came out to visit OH Ranch for Alberta Open Farm Days. Our guest book now holds names from many other provinces, and even other countries, including Australia, South Korea and the Netherlands.

An industry leader in animal care practices and protocols, the Calgary Stampede welcomes more than 7,000 animal guests during the Stampede and hundreds more throughout the year. Animals are at the heart of the Calgary Stampede and providing animal care is a top priority. Furthering our commitment to animal care best practice, the Stampede voluntarily shares our findings, participates in research and continuously strives to be open and transparent.

FITNESS TO COMPETE



The Stampede's Fitness to Compete program continues to show success in reducing heart and structural injuries in chuckwagon horses on the Stampede track. The powerful competitors in the Heavy Horse Pull also undergo pre-competition veterinary inspections on their hearts, lungs, bones and muscles to ensure they are fit to compete.

New in 2015, the University of Calgary Veterinary Sciences program began recording and studying the weight of these equine athletes upon their arrival at Stampede Park, prior to competition and post-competition.

Horses are checked by a veterinarian prior to each race to ensure Fitness to Compete criteria are met. Each horse that competes at the Calgary Stampede track is microchipped to help track health assessments, drug tests and mandatory rest days.

Everything from fencing to footing, all aspects concerning care, transport and housing considered. New animal care assessments in 2015 focused on transport and facilities, with the aim of ensuring animals arrive in a calm, comfortable state and are housed in the safest, most secure facilities.

THE CITY OF CALGARY

The City of Calgary is a longtime partner of the Calgary Stampede, providing our more than 100-year lease and support for our credit facilities. This partnership touches all our citizens year-round through programs within the community and activities at Stampede Park, including our annual 10-day celebration. Both organizations collaborated over the past two years in the aftermath of the 2013 flood to restore the riverbank, repair the pathway system and implement mitigation measures to protect the community asset in which Calgarians share the benefit. Support from the Flood Recovery Erosion Control (FREC) program enabled this work to be completed in 2015.

THE GOVERNMENT OF ALBERTA

The Government of Alberta supported a number of the Stampede's programs and facilities through an operating grant of \$7.8 million. Alberta Agriculture and Forestry provided a \$100,000 grant for agriculture programming and a grant for \$250,000, used specifically to replace the cabling in the barns and upgrade the sound system in Agrium Western Event Centre. The Disaster Recovery Program (DRP) enabled restoration of vital assets on Park damaged during the 2013 flood, including replacement of the pedestrian bridge over the Elbow River to ENMAX Park and the regional pathway.

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

The Government of Canada, through a \$255,646 Canadian Heritage - Building Communities through Art and Heritage grant, invested with the Stampede to restore eight historical murals, develop an on-line public Calgary Stampede Art Walk, and install an art piece to recognize 100 years of champions in Rodeo and Chuckwagon races.

Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, through the Canadian AgriMarketing program, committed \$14,190 to profile our international agriculture initiatives.
