Remember:

Wherever possible, complete hand-pulling before the field is sprayed.

If a field has been sprayed within the previous 48 hours do not enter to work.

Between 48 hours and 6 weeks after spraying, re-enter the field to work ONLY if clothed in appropriate workwear – that is boots, gloves and long trousers – and waterproof trousers if the crop is wet. From 6 weeks after spraying there are no requirements.

Sugar beet tops treated with Caligula must be disposed of and not fed to livestock.
