

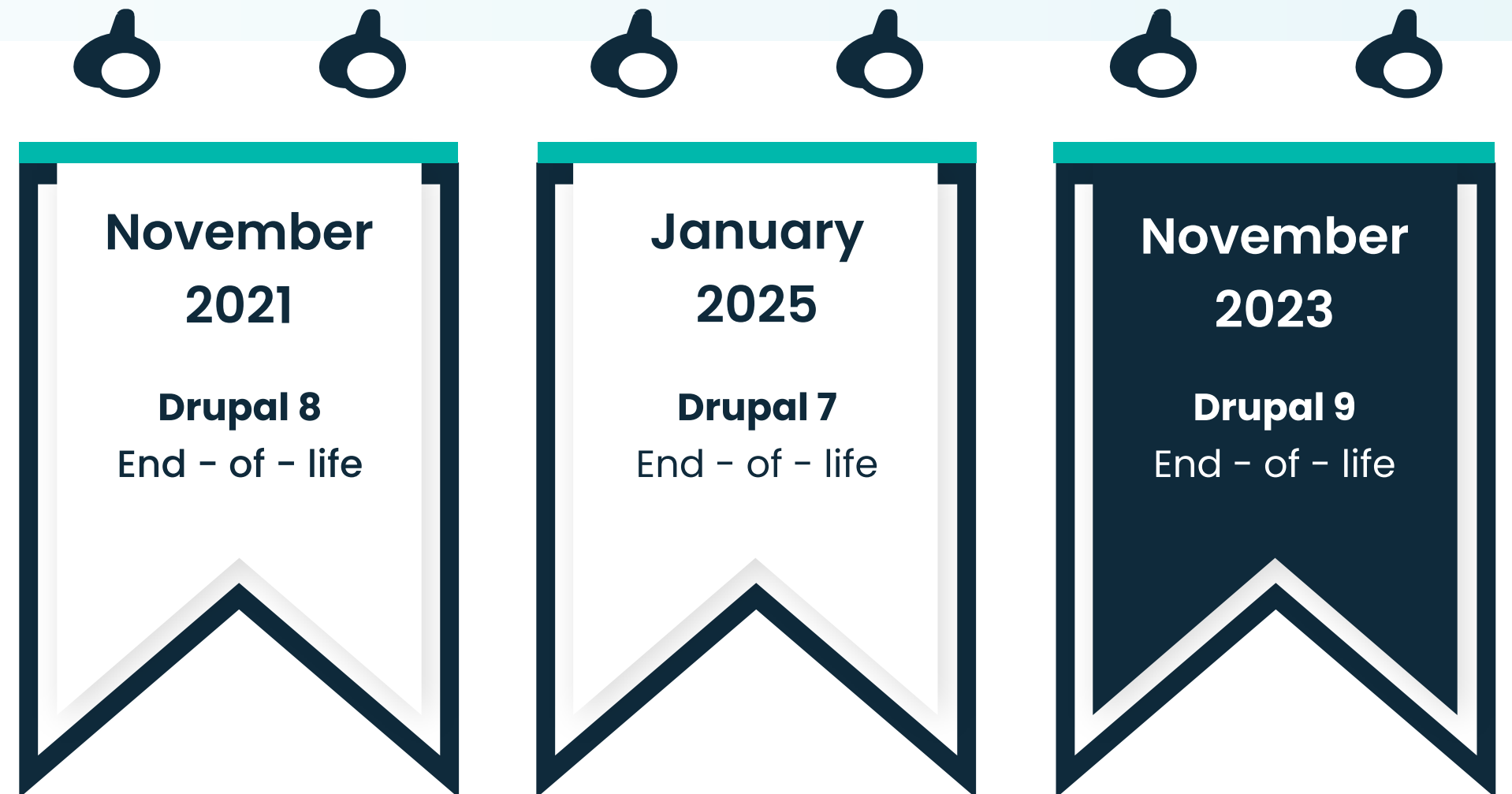

Drupal 10 FAQs

Drupal 10 (aka D10) was released 12/15/2022, just two years after the release of its predecessor Drupal 9. For current Drupal 9 users, this won't be a major overhaul of your current system, but it's still important to get familiar with the details of this upgrade to prepare for the new version. Users of earlier versions will have a few more steps to tackle. Let's get started!





When was Drupal 10 released?

What is the most current version of Drupal?

As of the date of this writing, September 2023, Drupal 10.1.3 is the current version of Drupal.

How long will Drupal 9 be supported?

Drupal 9 will be supported until November 2023.





What's Included in Drupal 10?

Unlike previous releases (like the transition from D7 to D8), Drupal 10 will not be a comprehensive overhaul. Instead, it will provide a variety of new or enhanced features.

Developers and marketers alike love Drupal for its key features like reusable content, integrated SEO tools, multi-channel publishing, and a deep level of personalization for website visitors. With the release of Drupal 10, there are even more valuable features to love! Not only does Drupal 10 offer a cleaner, leaner codebase[1], but it also paves the way for the future of digital marketing, thanks to decoupled CMS capabilities and modules that support Progressive Web Apps (PWA) and GraphQL query language for APIs.

[1]: The Drupal 9 to 10 transition removes many deprecated code references. Old deprecated code prevents older sites from breaking, but increases the size and complexity of the codebase. When Drupal 10 removes this old code, it will be lightweight and faster.





How to Prepare for the Drupal 10 Upgrade

Depending on what version of Drupal you're currently using, the process will vary when upgrading to Drupal 10:

Drupal 7 users:

While Drupal 10 will feature some tools to help upgrade from D7 to D10, it's highly recommended to upgrade to D10 as soon as possible. By upgrading at the earliest possible time, you ensure your website stays updated with the latest features and security measures.

Drupal 8 users:

Drupal 8's end of life occurred on November 2, 2021. The migration from D8 to D10 is generally straightforward, so it's in your best interest to initiate this upgrade as soon as possible.

Drupal 9 users:

If you're currently using Drupal 9, the time to upgrade is now! To position your site for a successful upgrade, keep your code updated, remove references to deprecated modules or custom code, and conduct ongoing site maintenance.

Prioritize your update and it will be an easy ride to Drupal 10 with just a simple core upgrade!
