

# **HOW TO DO PICTURES** FOR THE DAMAGE **REPORT?**

In order to properly record the accident, we need at least the following images:



**1** 4-side view

of the MILES vehicle and the opponent's vehicle



2 Damage report Overall picture of the MILES vehicle



3 Detailed view Picture of the damage at the MILES vehicle in detail



Pictures opponent's vehicle Repeat step 1 to 3 for the opponent's vehicle



#### 1 • 4-SIDE VIEW (MILES VEHICLE)

- Vehicle fully visible
- License plate identifiable
- **Good lighting conditions**


#### ) DAMAGE REPORT (MILES) 2

- **Diagonal view of the entire vehicle**
- Assembly (vehicle part) must be visible
- License plate must be identifiable






- Assembly not recognisable
- License plate missing




 Assembly clearly recognisable - License plate visible

#### DETAILED VIEW (MILES) 3

- Picture of the whole assembly
- If possible, the licence plate should be visible



- View to close!
- Damage location not identifiable



- Assembly clearly recognisable
- Damage location identifiable








- View to close!
- Assembly not clearly recognisable, therefore damage location not identifiable



 Assembly fully recognisable, therefore damage location identifiable


### **PICTURES OF THE** 4 **OPPONENT'S VEHICLE**

- Repeat step 🛈 to 🚯 for the opponent's vehicle
- Assembly with the damage needs to be fully visible
- ! License plate needs to be recognisable



- View to close!


- Assembly not clearly

- Assembly fully recognisable, therefore damage location identifiable



- View to close!
- Assembly not clearly recognisable, therefore damage location not identifiable
- License plate missing



Correct

- Assembly fully recognisable, therefore damage location identifiable
- License plate identifiable
