For this activity, you will need coloured pencils or pens, a piece of card, some glue, a pair of scissors and a push pin. Make sure you have a grown-up to help you!



Make a water-cycle wheel

Learn how the water on Earth is used over and over again by creating your own water-cycle wheel.

Instructions:

1. Colour in the pictures.
2. Ask a grown-up to help you with these next steps:
3. Stick this piece of paper to the piece of card and cut out the circles and the area shown on the top circle.
3. Attach the top circle to the bottom circle using a push pin.

Turn the bottom wheel to discover the four different stages of the water cycle.
