The Barack Obama Foundation is seeking proposals from vendors specializing in Contract Security. More information will be provided upon execution of a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).

What is the mission of the Obama Foundation?

The Foundation's mission is to inspire, empower, and connect people to change their world. That mission begins at home, on the South Side of Chicago, where the Foundation is building the Obama Presidential Center in the heart of historic Jackson Park. In addition to building the Obama Presidential Center, the Foundation currently has active programs all over the city of Chicago, country, and the world.

The Barack Obama Foundation is a nonprofit tax-exempt organization under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

What will the scope include?

The Obama Foundation is seeking a Contract Security provider that will support the Obama Presidential Center campus which is composed of four main buildings (the "Museum", "Forum", "Library", and "Home Court" buildings) totaling approximately 300,000 GSF on a landscaped, approximately 19.3 acre campus.

What does the Obama Foundation expect of bidders to the Contract Management RFP

- Be a professional and committed partner to the Foundation
- Offer diverse and local representation within a team that has expertise in the nonprofit sector and cultural institutions
- To ensure a safe and secure environment for all staff, visitors, collection, and exhibits.
- To deter and prevent theft, vandalism, and any unauthorized access to the premises.
- To enforce policies and procedures related to security and access control.
