The My Brother's Keeper Alliance (MBK Alliance) will release a Request for Proposal (RFP) mid-March 2024 seeking a Project Accelerator Implementor. More deadlines will be provided upon execution of a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).

What is the mission of the Obama Foundation?

The Foundation's mission is to inspire, empower, and connect people to change their world. That mission begins at home, on the South Side of Chicago, where the Foundation is building the Obama Presidential Center in the heart of historic Jackson Park. In addition to building the Center, the Foundation currently has active programs all over the city of Chicago, country, and the world. A "Legacy Program" of the Obama Foundation and White House, the My Brother's Keeper Alliance spearheads a nationwide call to action, uniting sectors to create safe and supportive communities for boys and young men of color.

The Obama Foundation is a nonprofit tax-exempt organization under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Can you provide a brief overview?

We seek a vendor experienced in designing and delivering technical assistance and training to 10 MBK Communities, contributing to a specific MBK Milestone with support from the MBK Alliance. The ideal vendor has a track record in driving systems-level change within a collective impact framework for organizations working with and for boys and young men of color. The selected vendor will create and implement a 12-month cohort experience for leaders of 10 MBK Certified Communities, advancing their impact work on a designated MBK Milestone through real-time and virtual convenings and technical assistance.

- Be a professional and committed partner to the Foundation and the My Brother's Keeper Alliance.
- Offer diverse representation within a team that has expertise in the nonprofit sector and cultural institutions that are familiar with working to advance systems for boys and young men of color.
- Satisfy prescribed budget and schedule requirements.
- Provide best solutions for the MBKA's success and population-level change work for boys and young men of color across the country.
- Commitment to working within Foundation frameworks, values, and leadership approaches.
