#### The Audition Pack

This is the fourth year that Crewe Lyceum Theatre will be delivering a Summer Youth Project, and we are so excited to be bringing around 70 - 80 young people to stage a musical in two weeks! The project is the product of a lot of hard work, and it is only through the commitment of everyone involved that the final result will be so spectacular.

Our participants have the opportunity to work with a highly skilled creative team including a professional Theatre Director, Choreographer, Musical Director & Technical team to create a full-scale musical on our main stage.

IMPORTANT: We are asking applicants to complete an <u>Online Audition Form</u> no later than Sunday 3rd May 2026 at 11PM. If you are choosing to audition via video submission, the same deadline applies. The audition form must be completed in full online.

#### Age Range

To apply for an audition, participants must be at least 8 years old and no older than 18 years old by Monday 10th August (proof of ID may be requested). Applicants must read through this pack and share the information with their parent/guardian if under 18 years of age.

It is important to highlight that we don't just expect the 'best' dancers, singers, and actors; we like to recognise potential and work with individuals throughout the process. If this is your first-time taking part in a musical or you are not too worried about being a speaking part, then the ensemble is the perfect place, as you get all the fun and experience of being in a musical without having to learn all the lines! You'll still get plenty of time on stage and there'll be lots of opportunities to be creative with your performance.

# **Auditions**

#### **Group Auditions**

Auditions will take place on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May at the Crewe Lyceum Theatre. You will be allocated an audition slot for the day ahead of attending. Please arrive on time at the main doors in order to hand in your forms & photo and get signed in. For security reasons, the front doors will be locked when everyone has signed in. Anyone arriving after their allocated time will be unable to audition.

Once everyone has signed in, we'll introduce the Creative and Production Team and outline the schedule for the day. You will learn a song and a dance and perform this for the Creative Team as part of a group.

Please ensure you bring plenty to eat and drink and do not bring anything valuable as we cannot be responsible for your personal belongings.

**Clothing**: Please wear sensible clothing and footwear to the auditions. Everyone will take part in a physical warm up so please come in comfortable, loose clothing. Please do not wear any jewellery. Please note you will not be allowed to audition barefoot or in socks.

Please note only people auditioning will be allowed into the auditorium. Parents and guardians will **not** be able to stay and wait for their children, so please be prepared to leave once they have registered.

#### **Principal Call Backs**

On Monday 11th May, those who were successful in being shortlisted for a principal role will be invited to a call back which will take place on Saturday 16th May from 1PM-5PM. You may also receive a short monologue or part of a song to prepare for the role we wish to see you for.

Please note we cannot guarantee a callback for a principal role to everyone who wishes to audition for one.

#### **Online Audition: Self-Tapes**

If you can't make it to the audition in person, we are offering the option to submit a video. If you need to send a video audition, please email Hannah at hannah.baldwin@trafalgar.global for full instructions on how to do this.

#### **Decisions**

You will be notified of the result of your audition by email no later than Friday 22nd May and will have 72 hours to accept your offer. The full cast list will be made public once all emails have gone out and places have been accepted. You will get a digital copy of the script, and we expect everyone to know their lines before the project starts in August.

#### **Ensemble/Speaking Parts**

If you are cast in the Ensemble, you will be informed of the scenes you'll appear in and the different characters you'll portray, giving you a clear idea of your time on stage. This production features a large ensemble, ensuring that everyone has a fair and meaningful amount of stage time.

The decision of the creative team is final and correspondence regarding casting will not be entered into.

#### Rehearsals

All rehearsals take place at the Crewe Lyceum Theatre, approximately 9AM till 5.30PM.

# **Fees**

The participation fee for this year's Summer Youth Project is £225.00 per participant (which works out at around £18.75 per day). Siblings of full paying places will be charged at £205.00.

The fee covers two full weeks of Summer Youth Project and **does not include meals, transport, or show tickets**. Please note that, once payment has been made, there are no refunds unless we can fill your place.

All fees must be paid by **Saturday 25th July**. Failure to pay will result in the exclusion of the participant from the Project. Details on how to pay will be emailed to you upon successful audition. You can also pay in instalments if you prefer, please contact Hannah at hannah.baldwin@trafalgar.global to arrange a payment plan.

#### **Subsidised Places / Bursary Funding**

#### **Costumes and Props**

Costumes and props will be provided, but participants will be asked to provide basic elements of a base costume that hopefully can be found at home or from a charity shop/supermarket for a few pounds.


