

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 These WBP ARENA LTD Scrooge Prize Draw Terms (the **Terms**) set out the terms on which you can enter the WBP ARENA LTD Scrooge Prize Draw to win one or more cash prizes as set out below (the **Prize Draw**).
- 1.2 The Prize Draw is a promotional prize draw and is neither a lottery nor any other form of gambling as set out in the Gambling Act 2005.

2. THE PROMOTER

- 2.1 The promoter of the WBP ARENA LTD Scrooge Prize Draw (the **Prize Draw**) is WBP Arena Ltd., a private limited company registered in England and Wales with company number 14698267 and a registered address at 1 Barons Court Graceways, Whitehills Business Park, Blackpool, England, FY4 5GP (the **Promoter**).

3. HOW TO ENTER

- 3.1 This is a promotional Prize Draw and is only available to you if you purchase one or more tickets (each a **Ticket**) from the Promoter for its production of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” which shall run from 11 December 2026 to 2 January 2027, except for the schools matinee performance in Blackpool Winter Gardens on Thursday 10 December.
- 3.2 The Prize Draw will open when tickets for “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza ” become available to purchase from 15 April 2026 up to and including the earlier of:
- (a) The date of the last showing of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” on 2 January 2027; or
 - (b) The date on which the last Ticket for all performances of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” between 11 December 2026 and 2 January 2027 is sold,
- this being the **Closing Date**.
- 3.3 Multiple entries per person are permitted. You will receive one entry for each Ticket for a performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” that you purchase.
- 3.4 You can purchase Tickets:

 - (b) By going to the box office at any of our venues, listed below, including in person or via their websites:

(v) Gleneagle Arena Killarney or at their website: www.gleneaglearena.ie.

- 3.5 You can only enter the Prize Draw by purchasing Tickets for a performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” as set out in clause 3.4, other than the schools matinee performance in Blackpool Winter Gardens on Thursday 10 December.
- 3.6 You are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms upon purchasing a Ticket and entering the Prize Draw. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry, or refuse to award the Prize to anyone in breach of these Terms.
- 3.7 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the Prize Draw where it becomes necessary to do so. In the unlikely event of the performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” for which you have purchased one or more Tickets being cancelled the Prize Draw will also be cancelled and you will receive a refund for any Tickets you have purchased.
- 3.8 Each Ticket purchase for a venue has an equal chance of winning the Prize Draw at that venue.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The Prize Draw is open to all people who have purchased a Ticket, except:
- (a) purchasers of Tickets for the schools matinee performance in Blackpool Winter Gardens on Thursday 10 December;
 - (b) employees of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - (c) employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the Prize Draw or its administration; or
 - (d) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
- 4.2 You can only be a Winner if you are present at the performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” for which you have purchased one or more Tickets. If a Winner is selected and they are not at the performance another Winner will be selected in their place.
- 4.3 Entrants into the Prize Draw may be under the age of 18 and could be a Winner of the Prize Draw. If a Winner is under the age of 18, the Winner must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at the performance and the acceptance of the Prize shall be subject to confirmation and consent from that parent or legal guardian.
- 4.4 In entering the Prize Draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the Prize Draw.
- 4.5 The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who it reasonably believes is in breach of these Terms.

5. PRIZE DETAILS

- 5.1 Each winner of the Prize Draw (each a **Winner**) will receive a cash prize of £1000 at the performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Extravaganza” at all venues other than Gleneagle Arena Killarney where the Winner will receive a cash prize of €1,000 (each a **Prize**).
- 5.2 The Prize is supplied by the Promoter.

5.3 The Prize is not negotiable or transferable and as the Prize is cash there will be no alternative prize provided.

6. THE WINNERS

6.1 The Winners will be chosen at random with all seat numbers included in the Prized Draw and being chosen on stage in front of the audience from a hat or tombola barrel during the performance of “Scrooge: Cirque Extravaganza” for which you have purchased one or more Tickets, the date of which shall be the date of the Prize Draw (the **Draw Date**) .

6.2 The Winners will be announced live during the performance of “Scrooge: A Cirque Spectacular”, for which you purchased one or more Tickets, by a member of the cast announcing the seat number of the Winner.

6.3 Winners shall collect their Prize by:

- (a) going up to the stage to collect their Prize in cash in person where they will be physically handed their Prize by a member of the cast. Winners can choose to allow one or more members of their party (if they have purchased multiple Tickets) to go to the stage to collect their prize including children provided that they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian; and
- (b) providing evidence of their Ticket or Ticket purchase if requested to do so.

6.4 If a Winner is under the age of 18:

- (a) the Prize may be presented on stage to the Winner for the purposes of the performance, but the Promoter reserves the right to arrange for payment of the Prize to the Winner’s parent or legal guardian on the Winner’s behalf;
- (b) the Promoter reserves the right to refuse on-stage participation by the Winner unless a parent or legal guardian is present;
- (c) the Promoter reserves the right to give the Prize to the parent or legal guardian of the Winner on their behalf; and
- (d) the Promoter may require the parent or legal guardian of the Winner to provide signed written consent for release of the Prize to the Winner.

6.5 Only people who are present at the performance are eligible to win a Prize and if your Ticket is selected but you are not present the Promoter shall draw another Winner at random as set out above.

7. PUBLISHING PRIZE DRAW DETAILS

7.1 The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the Promoter will (a) announce the ticket number of the Winner live on stage during the relevant performance; and (b) send the surname and county of Prize Winners to anyone who emails boxoffice@show2gotix.com or writes to the address set out in clause 2.1 (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after the Closing Date of the Prize Draw. The Promoter shall also announce the name of the Winner, and/or any member of their party that accepts the Prize on behalf of the Winner, during the performance of “Scrooge: a Cirque Extravaganza ” at which the Prize Draw takes place.

- 7.2 If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please let the Promoter know either in advance by contacting the Promoter or, if you are a Winner, at the time you are presented with the Prize. In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request. However, in all cases the name of the Winner shall be announced during the performance of “Scrooge: a Cirque Extravaganza”.
- 7.3 If a Winner is under the age of 18, any publication or use of the Winner’s name, image or recording for promotional purposes shall only take place with the consent of the Winner’s parent or legal guardian.
- 7.4 The decision of the Promoter regarding any aspect of the Prize Draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
- 7.5 The announcement of the Prize Draw will be recorded on video, and the recording and extracts from it:
- (a) shall be used by the Promoter for publicity purposes, unless the Winner objects;
 - (b) if the Winner is under 18, shall not be used by the Promoter for publicity purposes, unless the parent or legal guardian provides consent for such use.

8. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 8.1 To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the Winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

9. DATA PROTECTION AND PUBLICITY

- 9.1 The Promoter will only process your personal information as set out in thescroogecirque.com/contact. See also condition 7 and condition 7.2, with regard to the announcement of Winners.

10. GENERAL

- 10.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these Terms, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the Prize Draw.
- 10.2 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the Prize Draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 10.3 These terms and conditions are governed by English law. If any entrants to this promotion wish to take court proceedings, then they must do this within the courts in the United Kingdom.
