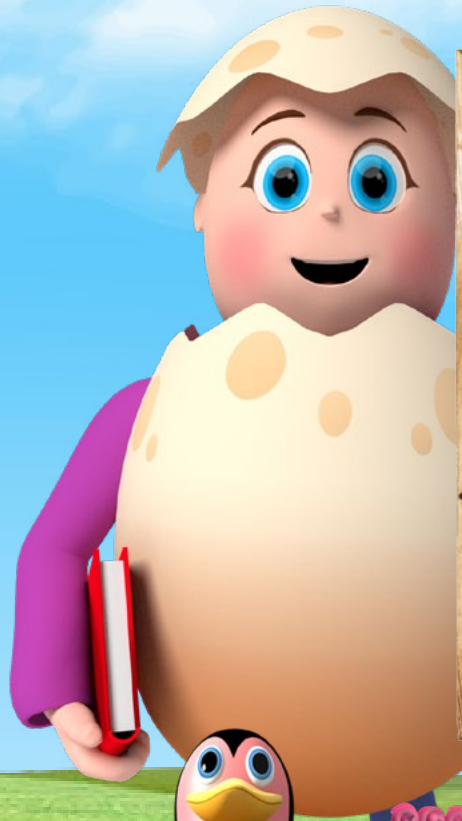

## Social, physical, and emotional skills

Before starting school, your child should be able to do most of these.

### Social and emotional

- My child can use words to describe their feelings.
- My child can play with others, share, take turns, and manage their emotions.
- My child can show empathy and kindness to others.

### Listening and communication

- My child can listen to and follow directions.
- My child can sit and listen to a story.
- My child is willing to ask and answer questions.

### Fine motor and self-care

- My child can get dressed and put their shoes on.
- My child can use buttons and zips.
- My child can go to the toilet and wash their hands.
- My child can blow their nose and brush their teeth.
- My child will eat a pre-packed lunch and clean up after themselves.
- My child knows their full name, address, and date of birth.

### Gross motor skills

- My child can clap his/her hands, unscrew lids, and turn handles.
- My child can walk up and down stairs.
- My child can hop on one foot, jump, skip, and stand on one foot.
- My child can kick and throw and catch a ball.

## Academic skills

Before starting school, your child should be able to do most of these.

### Reading

- My child has an interest in books, can hold them, and turn the pages.
- My child can talk about their favorite books and stories.
- My child can name most or all of the letters of the alphabet.
- My child knows the sounds that letters make.
- My child can recognize upper and lower case letters.

### Math

- My child can count to 10 or 20 or beyond.
- My child can count small groups of things.
- My child knows shapes, colors, and days of the week.
- My child knows terms such as morning, afternoon, night, yesterday, today, and tomorrow.
- My child can draw/copy circles, squares, and triangles.

### Learning tools

- My child can copy shapes and lines, write, and draw with a pencil and crayons.
- My child knows how to use paints and a paintbrush.
- My child can cut out shapes using age-appropriate scissors.
- My child can use paste to glue together a picture.
- My child can use puzzles, counters, and other learning tools.
- My child knows how to tidy up and put things away.
