The flower bunch craft is a great way of introducing a plant or season theme to little ones. The cutting and pasting involved in this craft are great ways to improve fine motor skills.

## **Materials**

- A3 craft paper
- Craft sticks
- Small and medium and large cupcake liners (3 per flower)
- Paper plate
- Child friendly scissors
- Glue
- Glitter



## **Helpful Hints**

A parent or carer should always be around during craft time. Keep safe and have fun.

To create the medium cupcake liners, trim the edges of the large cupcake liner.

Mix up the arrangement of cut and uncut cupcake liners to create a variety of different flower designs.

## **Extend/Enrich**


This is a great time to explain the seasons. This craft is the perfect springtime craft. A parent or carer can extend this activity by explaining that lots of flowers bloom in the sunny springtime after a cold winter.

## How to make your flower bunch!

- 1. Glue a large cupcake liner to the top of a craft stick.
- 2. Glue a medium and small cupcake liner layering them over the top of the larger cupcake liner.





- 5. Carefully cut a paper plate in half.
- 6. Glue one half of the paper plate on to a piece of craft paper to make a paper plate vase.
- 7. To finish your flower bunch, glue the flowers into the paper plate vase.
