This simple craft is a fun way to explore an insect theme. The pom-pom caterpillar craft is a great craft to explore the lifecycle of the caterpillar and butterfly. The pom-pom caterpillar craft is also a fun way of introducing colours, patterns and improving fine motor skills.

Materials

- Colourful mini pom-poms
- 2 small googly eyes per caterpillar
- 1 peg per caterpillar
- PVA glue



Helpful Hints

A parent or carer should be nearby during craft time. Keep safe and have fun.

Adding the small googly eyes can be tricky; make sure you have a parent or carer nearby to help you with this part.

Glue a magnet to the back of the peg so you can put it on your fridge to hang your favourite artworks and photos.


How many different colour patterns you can make with each pom-pom caterpillar?

HOW to make your Pom-pom caterpillars!

1. Squirt a line of glue along the peg.





3. Glue on two small googly eyes on to the first pom-pom, leave to dry.



4. Repeat steps 1, 2 and 3 until you have a group of as many pom-pom caterpillars as you want.



5. Now your colourful pom-pom caterpillar is ready!
