Lesson 18 • the letter **e** and sound **ee**

Learning objectives

Children will:

- identify the sound ee.
- identify words that contain ee.
- recognise and write e and E.

Other languages often do not distinguish between long and short vowel sounds. Students may mix them up when reading aloud and speaking. Find games for them to play where correct pronunciation and identification of sounds is important, like Bingo with word pairs such as fell and feel, met and meet, and so on.

Extra assistance

In many languages each sound has its own letter or symbol, so some students will need help to know when a vowel is pronounced with a short or long sound. The pair of sounds represented by e and ee are one instance to practise and learn.

Classroom activities

Decorate the Letters

Provide the students with a piece of paper that has many different forms of letter e on it – some dotted, some in bubble writing, some solid letters, a couple of capitals:


- trace over the dotted letters with different coloured pencils, textas or crayons
- glue collage materials such as paper bits, leaves or wool to the solid letters
- colour in the bubble letters with dots, stripes or shapes
