This craft will show you how to turn colourful cupcakes cases into a caterpillar or butterfly! This simple activity is a fun introduction to all things bug related. Additionally, this craft improves counting and fine motor skills in a fun way.

- Colourful cupcake liners (5 per caterpillar and 4 per butterfly)
- Coloured craft paper
- Craft sticks
- Googly eyes
- Glue
- Pom-Poms
- Crayons
- Stickers





Extend/Enrich


This is a great opportunity for children to learn about the life cycle of caterpillars and how they transform into butterflies.


Did you know a butterfly goes through a four stage life cycle? The life of the butterfly begins at the egg stage. When the egg begins to hatch, a caterpillar emerges from the egg. The caterpillar emerges really hungry and starts to eat lots of leaves. Once the caterpillar has finished eating and growing they form into a pupa. The pupa is the cool stage where the caterpillar quickly changes into a beautiful butterfly! Once the caterpillar has finished growing, a butterfly will emerge from its pupa home and will soon begin to flutter around.



HOW to make your catterpillar!

- 1. Flatten out 5 cupcake liners.
- 2. Glue the cupcake liners to the craft paper in a wavy pattern to form the head and body.






















HOW to make your butterfly!

- 1. Flatten out 4 cupcake liners.
- **2.** Glue 2 cupcake liners overlapping to form one wing. Repeat for the other wing.





- **5.** Draw on antennas and a little smiley face to finish your cupcake butterfly.
- **6.** Optional decorate the wings with crayons or glitter!
