



The pom-pom egg craft is a perfect Easter activity. Using pom-poms to paint will help children learn how to grasp pencils and paintbrushes. This activity helps kids to develop fine motor skills and improve shape recognition. All of these skills help ready young children for school.

Materials

- A3 craft paper
- Template
- Pom-poms
- Wooden pegs
- Paint
- Child friendly scissors
- Glue



Helpful Hints

This activity can be a bit messy. It's best to paint in an easy to clean area such as the kitchen or outdoors.

For the best result, use one pom-pom per paint colour.

Always have a parent or carer around during craft time. Keep safe and have fun!

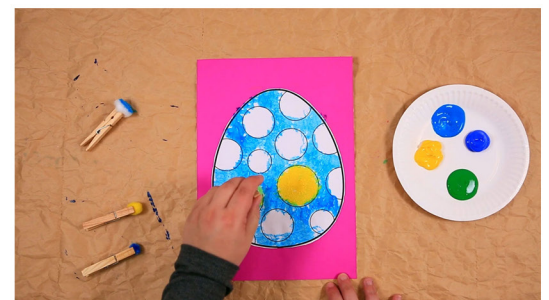
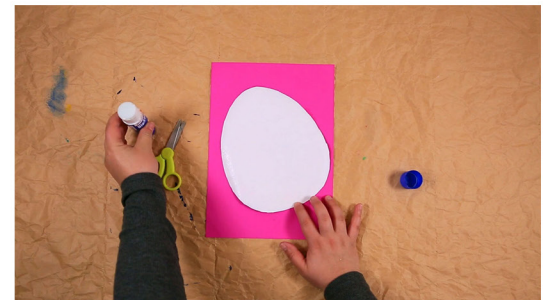

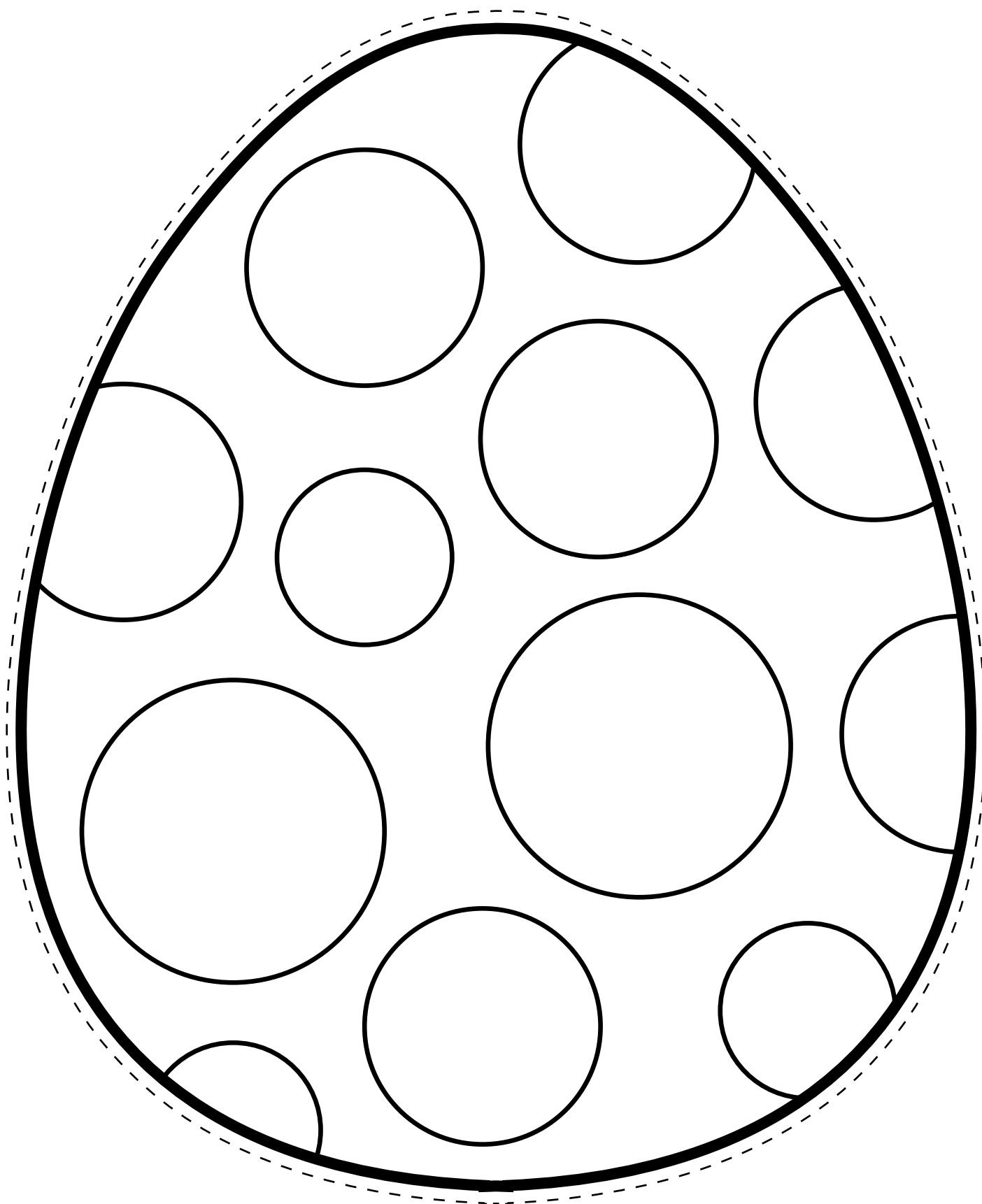


How to make your pom-pom eggs!

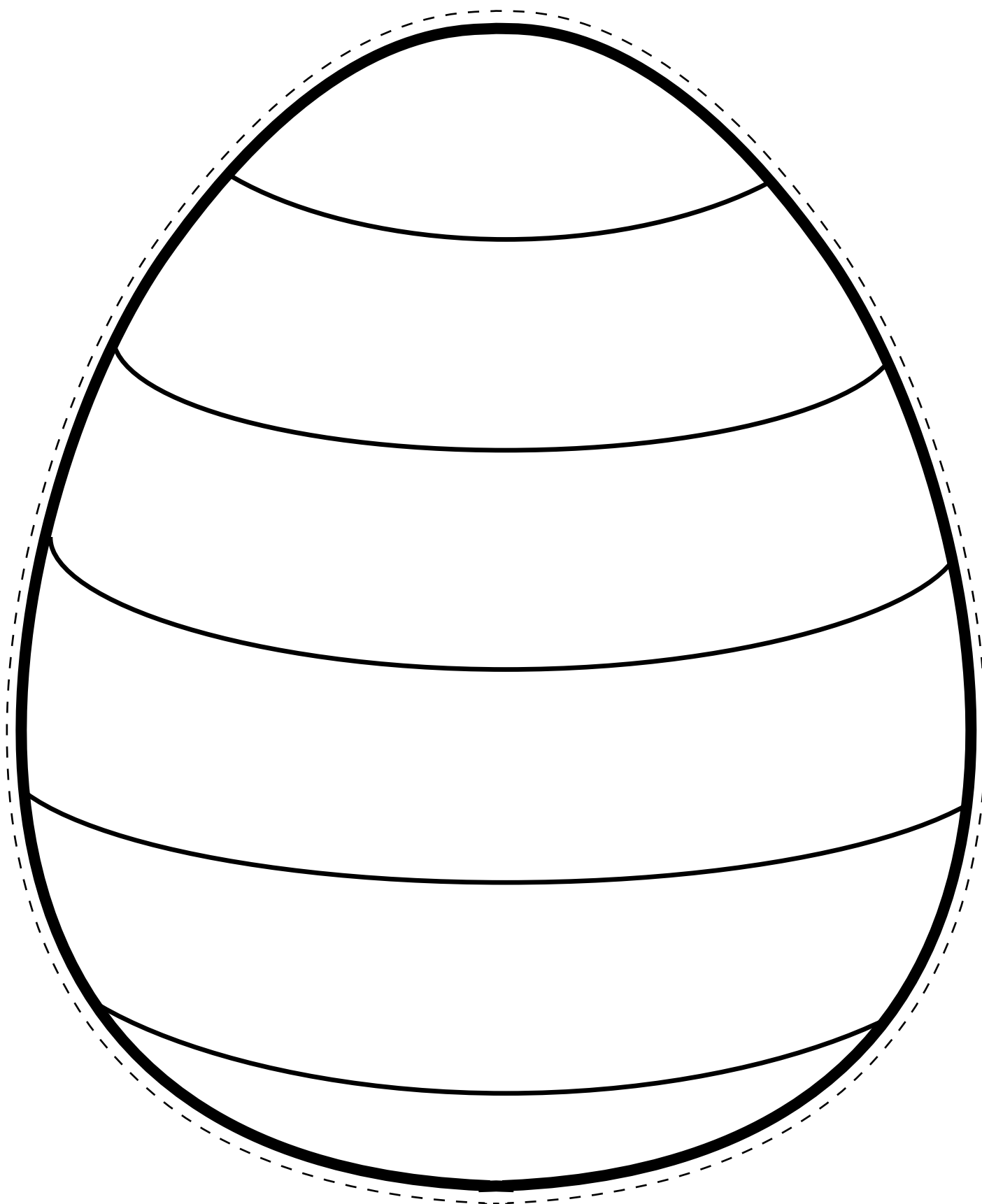
1. Carefully cut out the egg templates.
2. Glue the template onto the A3 craft paper.
3. Attach one pom-pom to each peg.
4. Pour a variety of colours onto a tray or plate.
5. Use the pom-pom peg as a paintbrush to paint your egg.
6. Allow to dry, repeat these steps with all of the pom-pom egg designs!



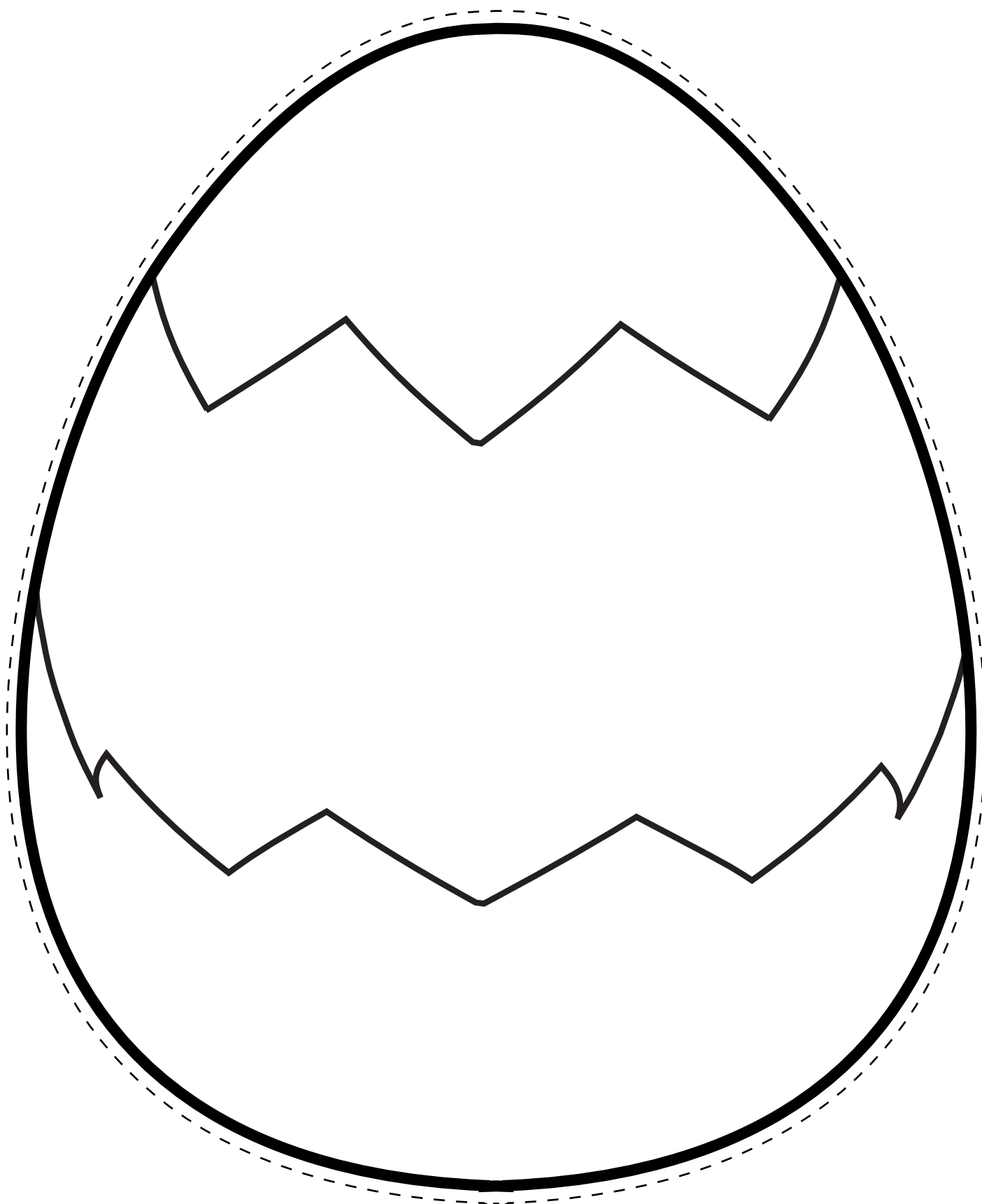
