- Googly eyes
- Child friendly scissors

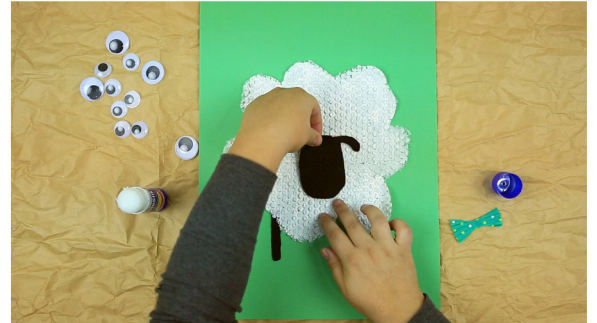
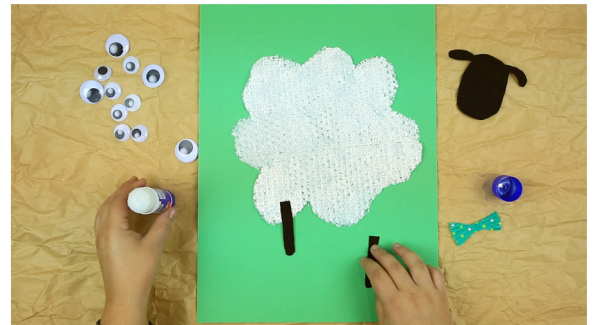
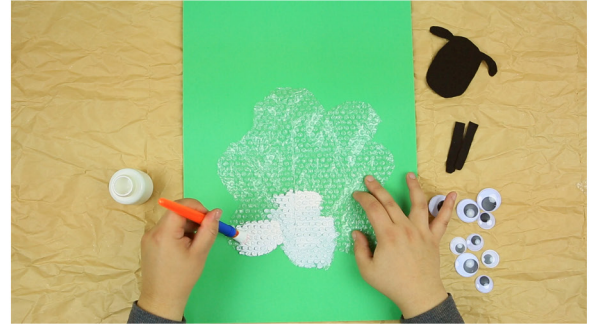
Can you think of any other animals that you could create out of black paper and bubble wrap?

Did you know sheep are very social animals and live in groups called flocks or herds?
Make a few bubble wrap sheep to create your own flock of sheep!



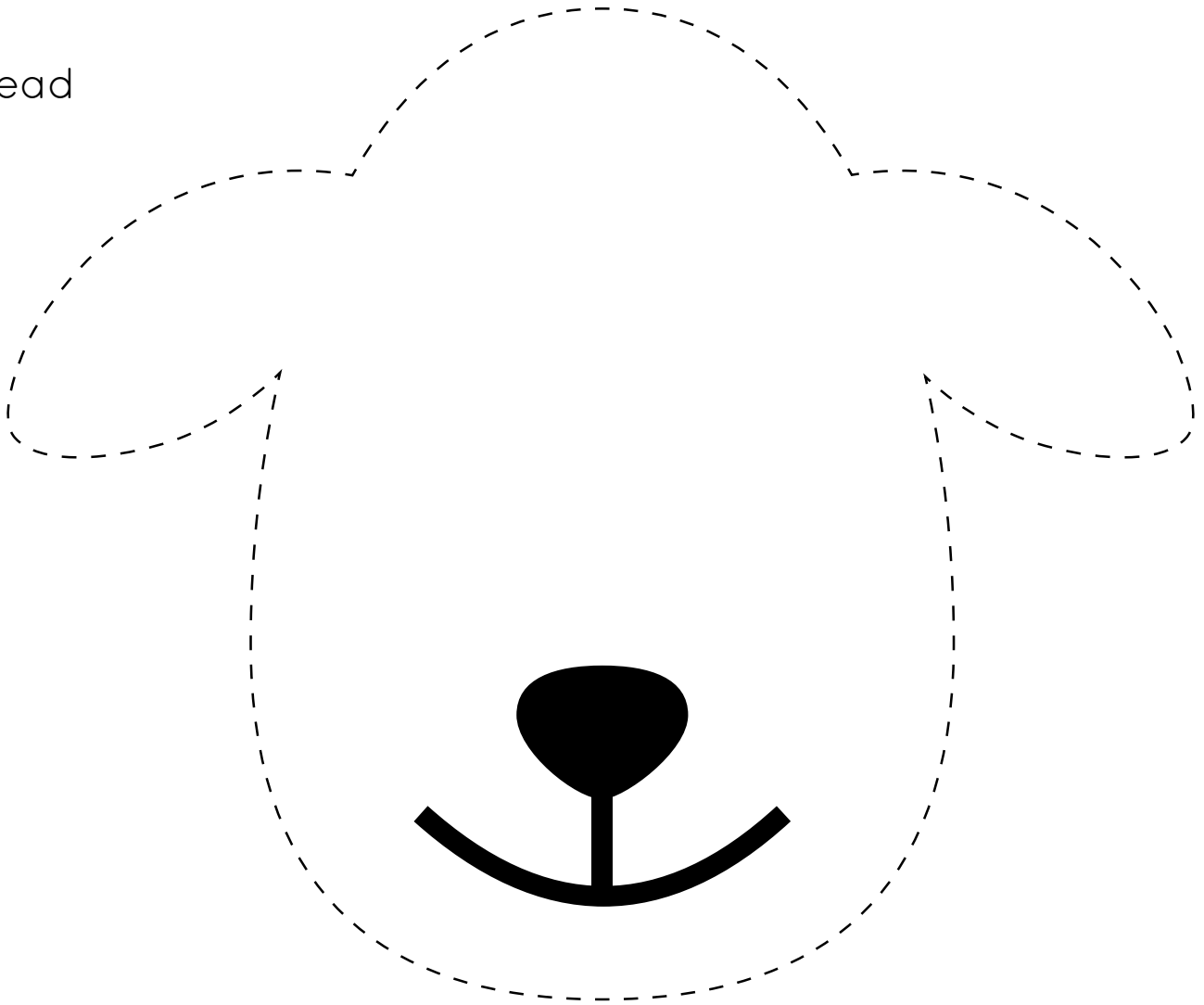
How to make your bubble wrap sheep!

1. Cut a wavy circle onto the bubble wrap to create the sheep's body.
2. Paint one side of the bubble wrap white, leave to dry.
3. Paint the printable template black, leave to dry.
4. Cut out the head and legs from the printable template. Glue the bubble wrap sheep's legs from the template cut-out on to the back of the bubble wrap.
5. Flip the bubble wrap over and glue the cut-out sheep's head to the middle of your bubble wrap sheep.
6. Glue on the googly eyes to make the sheep complete!
7. Optional: Use some ribbon or paper to make a little bow for the sheep.
