'Ahoy there!' for 30 young people

THIRTY young people from the borough are being given the chance of a lifetime to take part in September's prestigious Tall Ships Regatta.

They are being sponsored by Berkey Homes to sail aboard the Golden Levee, a 79 metre long, three-masted postal ship, reminiscent of the 1950's era. Aged between 16 and 25, the trainees are a mix of workers and students with aspirations of becoming ship engineers to journalists, marine microbiologists to architects.

Aboard the Golden Levee, the trainees will become part of a 60-strong crew and will gain hands-on experience of sailing a tall ship. One person taking part is Iosia Tamas, 21, a student at the University of Greenwich, who said: "For me, being able to experience and become part of Greenwich's history is an enormous privilege. As a student of architecture at the university here, I've had a chance to learn more about the area's heritage as well as bearing witness to the transformation that is happening in this part of the Woolwich. This is an exciting time for the royal borough of which I am sure the Tall Ships will prove to be the pinnacle of activity and a wonderful way of preserving the cultural heritage of this place."

Fellow student Huochen Shih, 23, who is studying maritime history, said: "Stories of life at sea have captivated me from a very young age and motivated me throughout my studies, but there's only so much you can learn from books and archives. This opportunity has made

my dream of experiencing life aboard sailing vessels a reality."

THE LEADER of the House of Commons and three baronesses helped officially open a university's flagship Education building. A HOSPICE has issued a warning following reports that a bogus fundraiser has been trying to sell its lottery tickets. Greenwich & Bexley Community Hospice was alerted after a scam in which a woman had been trying to sell its Winter Wonderland tickets door to door last week in the Abbey Terrace area of Abbey Wood. The charity is advising people that its fundraisers have ID and do not sell tickets via knocking on doors. Lucy Howe, from the hospice, said: "We are issuing a warning to let people know that we do not sign people up for our raffle or fundraising through door-knocking representatives. People can only buy our raffle tickets from the hospice shops and from hospice recipients. We do have our lottery sales assistant, David Milnes, who promotes and sells our lottery tickets three times a week in the local Co-operative and Asda shops, but never door to door." She said: "I urge people to be even more vigilant and under no circumstance hand over cash or bank details without checking with the charity first." The hospice provides free meals and end-of-life care for residents from both boroughs and relies heavily on fundraising to continue its work.
