Fireworks and sparklers.



Fuel paste and flammable liquids.



Soda cartridges.



Camping gas.



Poisons and household chemicals, including corrosives such as acids, alkalis and any apparatus including mercury.



Alcohol exceeding 70%.



Paint and paint thinner.



Gasoline.



Oxygen cylinders/underwater torches.



Briefcases installed with alarm devices.



Strong magnets/ lithium batteries/ e-cigarettes/ spare batteries and wet cell batteries in checked baggage.



Infectious Substances such as bacteria and live virus materials.



Radioactive material.



Mace/ Pepper spray.



Cigarette lighters in checked baggage.
