

## Getting Started with Jupyter Notebooks

Before you can run the Getting Started Jupyter Notebooks from the SDK Libraries in Factset's Developer Portal pages, you will need ensure that you have Anaconda properly installed on your computer. This page will walk you through the steps to download Anaconda and deploy Jupyter Notebooks.

1. Navigate to the Anaconda Installation page [HERE](#)
2. Select the appropriate operating system (if you are installing on Windows, select *Installing on Windows*)
3. Select Download the Anaconda Installer, and select Download from the new page
4. The installation file will take a few moments to download, once it does, follow the steps for the installation process
5. Once the installation is complete, search your computer for 'Jupyter Notebook'
  - a. The program will be named something like 'Jupyter Notebook (anacond3),' open it. You may want to pin the program to your taskbar for ease of access.
6. Jupyter Notebooks opens in a web browser and provides you with a file directory similar to 'File Explorer' in Windows. You can now navigate through your computer's directory (within the Jupyter Notebooks web page) to open files saved on your computer.
