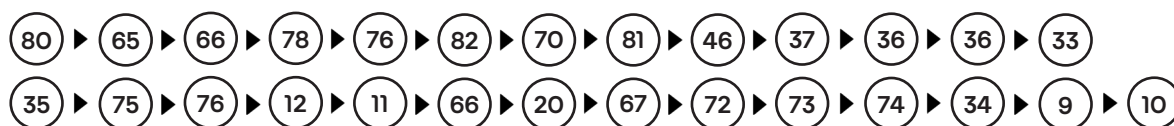

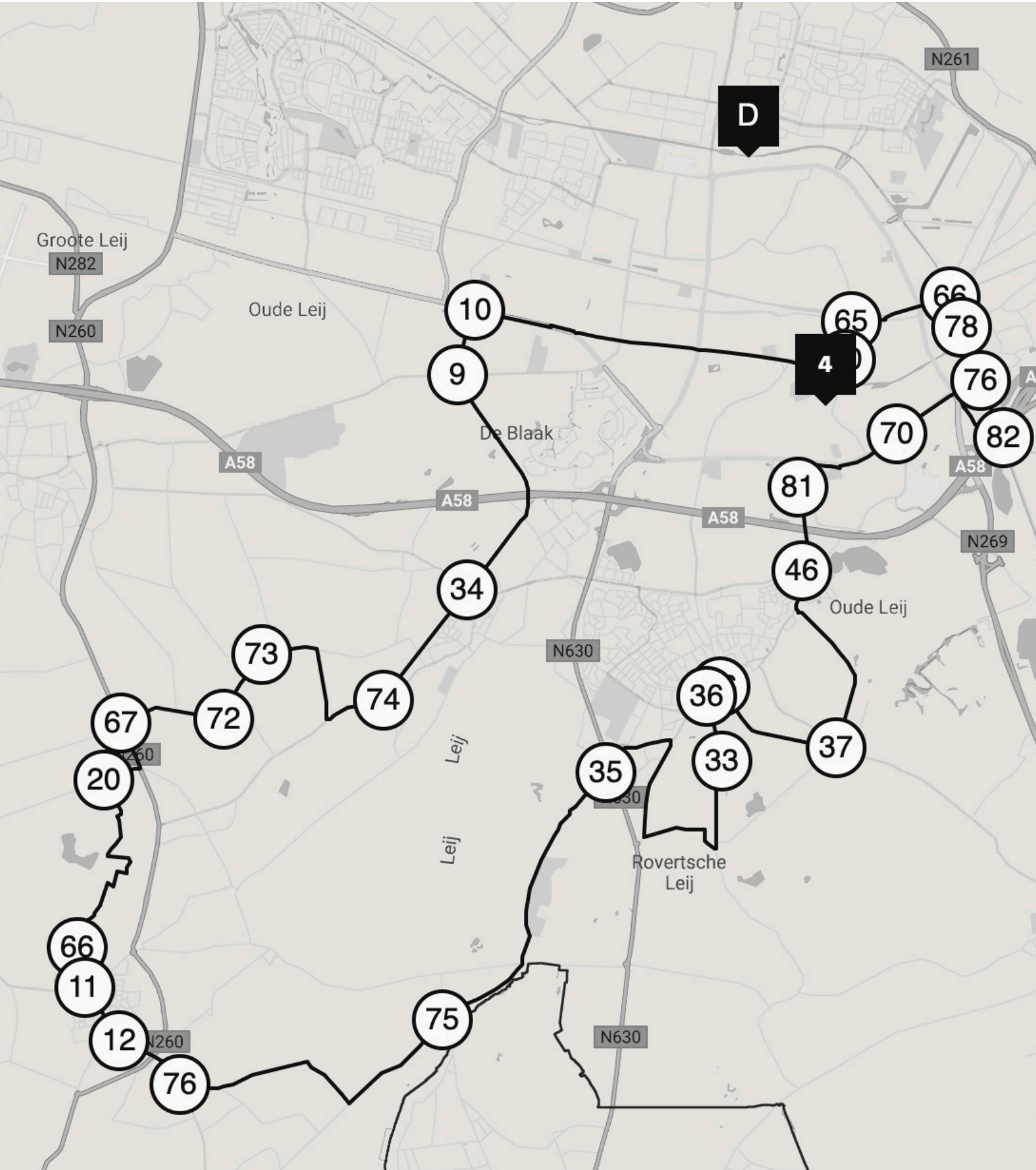
Cycle through the city where Van Gogh got his first drawing lessons

## Town Hall Palace

In the centre of Tilburg, in the middle of the city forum, stands the Palace of King William II. Once built by the king, it is now used by the municipality as the Town Hall Palace.
