## THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jesus Enters Jerusalem

**UNIT:** Easter

# **UNIT MEMORY VERSE:**

"But God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners." Romans 5:8

# **TEACHING TRUTH:**

Jesus is the Savior God promised

**READ:** Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19

**OPTIONAL:** "The True King" (pages 427-432) from The Beginner's Bible

### WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

- 1. Where did Jesus and His disciples travel to so they could celebrate Passover? (*Jerusalem*)
- 2. What animal did Jesus ride into the city? (A donkey)
- 3. Were the people happy to see Jesus? (Most of the people were very happy to see Jesus.)
- 4. What did they do when they saw Him? (They waved palm branches when they saw him.)

### WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

- 1. Why do you think the leaders in Jerusalem were not happy to see Jesus come into the city? (They were jealous of Jesus and did not like how the people followed and praised Him.)
- 2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Jesus is the Savior God promised.)
- 3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He sent us Jesus, the Savior, just like He promised.
