




God is consistent even when we are not




Consistency Constantly following God and His Word




God's people were free from Egypt and Pharaoh!

a land filled with good things.




God led His people, the Israelites, with a cloud during the day and a pillar of fire at night.




But Pharaoh changed his mind. He did not want the Israelites to leave. He sent his army to catch them.







God's people were trapped at the edge of a great sea. They were scared. They did not trust that God could rescue them. Even though they were not consistent, God still was.
