ELEMENTARY DISCUSSION GUIDE

CHARACTER TRAIT: Humility

DEFINITION: Living with the right understanding of who God is, who I am, and who you are

MEMORY VERSE: "Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too."

PHILIPPIANS 2:3-4

FINISH LINE: Jesus is the perfect example of humility

READ: Philippians 2:3-11

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (Observation)

- 1) Who is our perfect example of humility? (Jesus) Look at verse 6. Who is Jesus? (He is God.)
- 2) Look at verse 8. What was Jesus' ultimate example of humility? (He was obedient and died on a cross.)
- 3) Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (Christ died for our sins.) Did he stay dead? (No! He came back to life 3 days later.)
- **4) Flip back to Philippians 2 and look at verse 9. What did God the Father do?** (He raised Jesus up and gave Him the place of highest honor.)
- 5) Look at verses 10-11. What will Jesus receive because of who He is and what He did? (He will receive worship and praise from everyone!)

WHAT DOES IT MEAN? (Interpretation)

- 1) Look at verse 7. What did Jesus choose to give up? (Because He is God, He has God's power. When He came to earth, He could have used that power to make His life easier but He didn't.)
- 2) Reread verses 3-4. How did Jesus show the kind of humility these verses talk about? (Because He loves us, Jesus came down from heaven and suffered for us. That's the most unselfish thing anyone has ever done!)
- 3) Why is it good news for us that Jesus was willing to show this kind of humility? (Because of our sin, we owe God a debt we could never pay and our relationship with Him is broken. Jesus humbled Himself, came to earth, lived a perfect life, and paid the debt we owe when He died on the cross. When we have faith in Him, we can be forgiven and have a relationship with God!)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (Application)

- 1) Verse 5 tells us our attitude needs to be the same as Jesus'. Do you think any of us could do that on our own? Why not? (No. We are all sinners and none of us are perfect like Jesus.)
- 2) Who can we ask to help us show this attitude of humility? (God) Talk about some ways you need God to help you show humility this week. Spend time as a family praying for God's help in those situations.
