
God takes care of us




Moses and the Israelites were traveling to the land God promised them.




The Israelites started complaining about food.



God promised to rain food down from heaven, quail as meat to eat and manna for bread.




God gave the people instructions to only gather enough food for one day and no more.




In the morning, the people woke up and saw a white, flaky thing on the ground that tasted like honey.


They called it manna because they didn't know what it was.




Moses said it was the bread God gave them to eat.




The people picked up what they could eat.




Moses said not to keep any of it until morning.



Some of the Israelites disobeyed God and kept extra food. The next day the food was full of bugs and smelled terrible.













But God gave them manna for 40 years!




God takes cares of us.
