THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Ten Lepers

UNIT: Miracles

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"I praise you for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

Psalm 139:14

TEACHING TRUTH:

Jesus has the power to heal

READ: Luke 17:11-19

OPTIONAL: "Ten Lepers" (pages 405-408) from [The Beginner's Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. What is a miracle? (*A miracle is something wonderful only God can do.*)
2. How many sick men were there, and who healed them? (*There were ten sick men, and Jesus healed all of them.*)
3. How many of the men told Jesus, "Thank you!" after they were healed? (*Only one man thanked Jesus.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. How can we praise Jesus for how He takes care of us? (*We can pray and thank Him for His care. We can also tell others about how Jesus takes care of us. When we tell others, it gives them the chance to praise God, too!*)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Jesus has the power to heal.*)
3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He has the power to heal and for always taking care of us.
