SCRIPTURE: Luke 2:1-20

FINISH LINE: We can be made pure because of Jesus

ACTIVITY 1: MEMORY VERSE GAME

SUPPLIES: Dominoes/Legos/Blocks, dry erase marker or sticker to write words on

SET UP: Write a word from this month's memory verse, Psalm 51:10, on each object with a dry erase marker or place a sticker on it first to write on.

DIRECTIONS: Unscramble the objects to write out this month's memory verse. After you have laid them out in order, read the verse all together. You can keep practicing by scrambling the words a few times and see if you can put the verse in order faster each time!

ACTIVITY 2: LESSON REVIEW

SUPPLIES: Red and white striped candy cane, poem below

DIRECTIONS: Learn how to tell others the good news about Christmas using a simple candy cane. Use the poem below to point out what the different parts of the candy cane stand for and how it can be used to share the gospel. After reading it, let the kids explain it in their own words. Brainstorm together who you can share this with during the Christmas season this year.
