
**This Week's Finish Line:**


**Jesus and his disciples were walking.  
They saw a man who had been born blind.**




**Jesus said told them the man's blindness happened  
so God's power could be seen in the man.**




**Then Jesus spit on the ground, made mud,

Jesus told him to wash his eyes in a pool.**





**The man washed his eyes, and then he could see!  
He told all his neighbors that Jesus healed him.**




**The neighbors couldn't believe it was really him,
