THIS WEEK'S STORY:

The Fiery Furnace

UNIT: The Old Testament

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Call to me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things that you do not know."

JEREMIAH 33:3

TEACHING TRUTH:

Only God should be worshipped

READ: Daniel 3:8-28

OPTIONAL: "Fiery Furnace" (pages 247-250) from The Beginner's Bible

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

- 1. What did Nebuchadnezzar tell everyone to do? (He ordered them to bow down and worship the golden statue he created of himself.)
- 2. Why did Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego not bow down when the music played? (They knew that only God should be worshipped and they did not want to bow down to anyone but Him.)
- 3. Who protected the men when they were thrown into the fiery furnace? (God protected them so they were not hurt in the fire.)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

- 1. Who are we supposed to worship? (Only God and no one else)
- 2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Only God should be worshipped.)
- 3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that He alone should be worshipped.
