THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jacob

UNIT: Patriarchs

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"God's way is perfect. All the Lord's promises prove true."

Psalm 18:30

TEACHING TRUTH:

God always loves us

READ: Genesis 27:1-29

OPTIONAL: "Isaac's Blessing" and "Jacob & Esau Meet Again" (pages 58-62 & 66-70) from [The Beginner's Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. What were the names of Isaac's two sons? Who was older and who was younger? (*Jacob and Esau. Esau was the older brother and Jacob was the younger brother.*)
2. How did Jacob trick his father? (*He pretended to be his brother Esau so he could get the special blessing from his father.*)
3. Did God love Jacob even after he tricked Isaac? (*Yes, because even when we sin and do wrong things, God still loves us.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Does God still love us when we make bad choices and sin? (*Yes, God always loves us.*) What can we do when we make bad choices and sin? (*When we sin, we can ask God to forgive us, and ask Him to help us make better choices next time.*)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God always loves us.*)
3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God for always loving us no matter what.
