# **TEACHING TRUTH:**

God has power over everything

#### **READ:** Exodus 7:1-5; 12:21-32

**OPTIONAL:** "Ten Plagues" (pages 104-110) from <u>The Beginner's Bible</u>

#### WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

- Who caused the plagues to come, and how many were there? (God sent the ten plagues and showed He has power over everything.)
- 2. What plague sounds the worst to you and why? (Answers will vary.)
- 3. What did the Israelites have to do to be protected from the 10<sup>th</sup> plague? (*They had to put the blood of a lamb around the doors of their houses.*)

#### WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

- 1. Why is Jesus called our Passover lamb? (Just like the lamb's blood saved the Israelites from death when the angel passed over their houses, Jesus shed His blood when He died on the cross. Because He died and came back to life, we can be saved and have forgiveness for our sins.)
- 2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God has power over everything.)
- 3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He has power over everything!
