



This week's Teaching Truth: Knowing God loves us helps us trust His Word







Josiah was an eight-year-old boy when he became king of Judah.




Josiah loved God and tried to do what was right in God's eyes.




When Josiah grew up, he started work to repair God's temple. The temple was broken down.




While they were working, Hilkiah the high priest found the scroll of God's Law. It had been missing. God had given them the Law because He loved them.




The book of God's Law was read to King Josiah. He tore his clothes because he was so upset to hear how he and the people had not been doing what God said is best.




Josiah had the book of God's Law read to all the people. It reminded them that God loved them and told them how they could love Him back by following His Word.
