

PRESCHOOL ACTIVITY GUIDE

TODAY'S STORY: Abraham

TEACHING TRUTH: God always keeps His promises

ACTIVITY 1: STORY REVIEW — Pass the baby

SUPPLIES: Baby doll

- 1. Have the children sit in a circle and pass a baby doll around the circle as fast as they can (like hot potato) while music is playing.
- 2. When the music stops, the child holding the baby gets to say, "Isaac is born! God always keeps His promises!"
- 3. Continue playing until everyone has had a turn to celebrate God keeping His promises.

ACTIVITY 2: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW — God always keeps His promises

SUPPLIES: Piece of paper, markers, miscellaneous craft supplies

- 1. On the top of a piece of paper, write God always keeps His promises.
- 2. Help your child draw four or five large stars on the paper.
- 3. Help your child think about different promises God has made to us. (Example: God promises to love us. God promises to listen when we pray. God promises to teach us. God promises to provide for us. God promises to help us.)
- 4. Write these promises inside the stars and remind your child that God always keeps His promises.
- 5. Let your child decorate the stars with whatever craft supplies you have available.

ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW - Psalm 18:30 - Rock Star

SUPPLIES: Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), something to use as a microphone

- 1. Sit in a circle on the floor.
- 2. Give one person a fake microphone. You could use a spatula, hairbrush, ice cream scoop, etc.
- 3. Play the memory verse song and have the entire group sing along. Whoever has the microphone gets to stand in the center of the circle and be the Rock Star.
- 4. When the song is over, pass the microphone to the next person.
- 5. Repeat until everyone has had a chance to be the Rock Star.
