THIS WEEK'S STORY:

God Calls Moses

UNIT: Moses and Joshua

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

JOSHUA 1:9

TEACHING TRUTH:

God is always with us

READ: Exodus 3:1-15

OPTIONAL: "A Baby in a Basket" & "The Burning Bush" (pages 92-103) in [The Beginner's Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Who was with baby Moses when he was in the basket on the river? (*God was with him and protected him.*)
2. What was special about the burning bush Moses saw in the wilderness? (*God talked to Moses from the bush, and the bush never burned up!*)
3. When God spoke to Moses from the bush, what did He ask Moses to do? (*God asked Moses to go to Egypt and lead the Israelites out of slavery to an amazing land He promised to give them.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Who did God say would be with Moses when he went to Egypt? (*God promised that He would be with Moses to help him.*)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God is always with us.*)
3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that He is always with us no matter where we go.
