

PRESCHOOL ACTIVITY GUIDE

TODAY'S STORY: Paul's Travels

TEACHING TRUTH: We can tell others about Jesus

ACTIVITY 1: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW – We can tell others about Jesus

SUPPLIES: Paper, tape, crayons

1. Help your child make a megaphone. Start by giving your child a blank piece of white paper.
2. Let them draw hearts all over the paper in different sizes and colors.
3. Help them roll the paper into a funnel shape and use pieces of tape to secure the paper into a funnel.
4. Have your child use the funnel as a megaphone and say, "Jesus loves you!" (Speak into the smaller end.)
5. Remind your child that **we can tell others about Jesus**.

ACTIVITY 2: STORY REVIEW – Traveling Far and Wide

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES: Megaphone from Activity 1

1. Today you are going to play a version of Follow the Leader. Explain that you are all are going to go on a journey like Paul to tell others that Jesus loves them. Remind them that Paul traveled really far, sometimes by boat and sometimes on foot, to tell people about Jesus and His great love for them.
2. Have everyone line up in a straight line. Whoever is at the front of the line will be the leader.
3. Walk through your house and/or yard, following the leader at the front. Take turns pretending to row a boat, as if you are traveling on the water, and marching, as if you are traveling on a long walking path.
4. Every now and then, let them use their megaphones (from Activity 1) to share the good news by shouting, "Jesus loves you!" as they row or march on their journey through the house and yard.
5. Allow everyone to have a turn being the leader.

ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW – Psalm 107:1 – Rock Star

SUPPLIES: Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), something you can use as a microphone

1. Sit in a circle on the floor.
2. Give one person a fake microphone (spatula, hairbrush, ice cream scoop - be creative!)
3. Play the memory verse song and have the entire group sing along with the song. Whoever has the "microphone" gets to stand up in the center of the circle and be the Rockstar.
4. When the song is over, pass the microphone along to the next person.
5. Repeat until everyone has had a chance to be the Rock Star.
