David and Goliath

UNIT: Kingdom

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path."

Psalm 119:105

TEACHING TRUTH:

God always wins

READ: 1 Samuel 17:32-50

OPTIONAL: "David and Goliath" (pages 173-180) from [The Beginner's Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Why were the Israelites so afraid of the Philistine army? *(They had a giant in their army named Goliath.)*
2. Who did God send to fight the giant? *(A shepherd boy named David)*
3. What did David use to defeat Goliath? *(He used a stone and his slingshot.)* How was David able to defeat a giant this way? *(God was more powerful than Goliath and God helped David defeat the giant.)*

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. When can we trust God? Can we trust God even when we are faced with a scary situation? *(Yes! God is all-powerful, and we can always trust Him in any situation.)*
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? *(Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth. God always wins.)*
3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that He is all-powerful and always wins.
