THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jesus Goes Home

UNIT: Easter

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"But God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners."

Romans 5:8

TEACHING TRUTH:

Jesus is the only way to God

READ: Matthew 28:1-10, 16-20 or Luke 24:35-53

OPTIONAL: "Going Home" (pages 318-325) [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Were Jesus' disciples happy to see him? *(Yes! They were so excited that Jesus was there and that He was alive.)*
2. What did Jesus tell His disciples to do? *(He told them to go to the whole world and tell people that we can be with God forever because Jesus died on the cross for our sin and came back to life.)*
3. At the end of the story, where did Jesus go? *(He went home to heaven.)*

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Do you think Jesus wants us to tell people about Him, too? *(Yes! Just like Jesus told His disciples to tell others about Him, He wants us to do this, too.)*
2. Who can we tell? *(We can tell anyone we meet.)*
3. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? *(Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Jesus is the only way to God.)*
4. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He sent Jesus and for showing us that Jesus is the only way to God.
