Jesus Feeds the 5,000

UNIT: Miracles

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

Psalm 139:14

TEACHING TRUTH:

Jesus has the power to provide

READ: Matthew 14:13-21, Mark 6:30-44, Luke 9: 10-17, or John 6:1-15

OPTIONAL: "Filled Full" (pages 244-249) from [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. How many people were with Jesus? *(There were 5,000 men plus women and children.)*
2. What did the little boy have to offer Jesus? Was this a lot of food? *(The boy had five loaves of bread and two fish; it was not very much food.)*
3. What happened when the disciples started to pass out the boy's food to the people? *(The food never ran out. There was enough to feed all the people who were there.)*
4. Who made this happen? *(Jesus! He performed a miracle and provided the food.)*

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Who has the power to give us what we need? *(God does!)*
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? *(Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Jesus has the power to provide.)*
3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He has the power to provide and give us what we need.
