



Courage Being brave because God is with me





This week's Finish Line: We can have courage because of who God is







Paul was being sent to Rome to stand trial before Caesar for telling people the good news about Jesus.




Paul was a prisoner. He was being sent on a ship with other prisoners, Roman soldiers, and his friend Luke.




The weather was getting bad, and Paul suggested they stop sailing.




The sailors and soldiers did not listen to Paul, and the ship kept on sailing.




The storm was terrible! The sailors tried everything to keep the boat from sinking.
