# PRESCHOOL DISCUSSION GUIDE

## THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jesus and the Children

**UNIT:** Jesus

## UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." **Matthew 19:14**

## TEACHING TRUTH:

Anyone can come to Jesus

**READ:** Matthew 19:13-14, Mark 10:13-16, or Luke 18:15-17

**OPTIONAL:** "The Friend of Little Children" (pages 256-263) from [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

## WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Did Jesus want the children to come to Him? (Yes! Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me.")
2. Was Jesus too busy to spend time with the children? (No. Jesus is never too busy for anyone to come to Him.)
3. Can we still come and talk to Jesus even though we cannot see Him? (Yes, we can pray and talk to Jesus anytime we want to. He always listens to us.)

## WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Does Jesus love children? Does Jesus love you? (Yes, and yes! Jesus loves everyone. He loves you so much and wants you to come to Him and talk to Him.)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Anyone can come to Jesus.)
3. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that anyone can come to Him and for loving you so much.
