# PRESCHOOL ACTIVITY GUIDE

TODAY'S STORY: Noah (Genesis 6-9)

**TEACHING TRUTH:** God's way is the best way

## ACTIVITY 1: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW – God's way is the best way

#### SUPPLIES: None

- 1. Play follow the leader. Be the leader and have everyone else follow you around the house or outside.
- 2. Do fun things along the way such as:

Hop, skip, or crawl Walk in a zigzag or like a duck Sing a song Give everyone high-fives Shout, "God's way is the best way!"

- 3. Remind everyone that we can trust God and obey Him because **God's way is the best way**.
- 4. Switch it up and let someone new lead the way.

### ACTIVITY 2: STORY REVIEW – Noah and the ark

#### **SUPPLIES:** Cardboard box, stuffed animals

- 1. Take an empty cardboard box, turn it on its side, and pretend it is an ark. Feel free to have your child decorate the outside of their ark if they would like.
- 2. Grab different types of stuffed animals and have your child pretend to be Noah, guiding all of the animals onto the ark.
- 3. If the box is big enough, have your child get inside and pretend to have it rain on the ark by tapping the cardboard with your fingers.
- 4. After the "storm" is over have your child climb out of the box, take out all of the animals, and praise God for keeping them all safe.

## ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW – Genesis 1:1 – Hot Potato

#### SUPPLIES: Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), a ball

- 1. Sit in a circle on the floor.
- 2. Explain that you will sing along with the memory verse song and carefully pass the ball while the music plays.
- 3. Stop the music when the verse is over.
- 4. Whoever has the ball when the music stops will stand and shout the verse address (Genesis 1:1).
- 5. OPTION: Instead of using the song, a grownup can say the verse one word at a time. With each word, pass the ball to the next person. Whoever has the ball at the end will stand and say the verse address.
