PRESCHOOL ACTIVITY GUIDE

TODAY'S STORY: The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)

TEACHING TRUTH: God wants us to show everyone His love

ACTIVITY 1: STORY REVIEW – Act It Out

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES: Costumes (like sheets or robes), props (bandages, toilet paper, coins)

- 1. Gather the costumes and props you want to use to help you act out the story of the Good Samaritan.
- 2. Assign each person a role to play from the story including the hurt man, priest, Levite, Samaritan, donkey, and innkeeper. Some people may get to play more than one character.
- 3. Retell the story from Luke 10:25-37 while everyone else acts it out.
- 4. Afterwards, talk about how the Samaritan showed God's love to the hurt man. Also, talk about how we can show other's God's love by helping them.

ACTIVITY 2: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW – God wants us to show everyone His love

SUPPLIES: Paper, crayons, markers, stickers

- 1. Remind your child that God wants us to show everyone His love. Who is everyone? Talk about who "everyone" includes. (Examples: People who look like you and those who do not look like you, people who are kind and those who are mean, people who have a lot and those who do not have much, etc.)
- 2. Make a list of people you might see and could show God's love to this week. (Examples: Parents, siblings, other family members, friends, neighbors, etc.)
- 3. Choose a few people from your list and make cards for them using your supplies.
- 4. Grownups, you may want to write, "God loves you!" on the front of the cards for your child.
- 5. Let your child draw pictures and decorate the cards.
- 6. Do not forget to deliver the cards! Be sure to tell each person that God loves them.

ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW – Matthew 22:37 & 39 – Rock Star

SUPPLIES: Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), something to use as a microphone

- 1. Sit in a circle on the floor.
- 2. Give one person a fake microphone. You could use a spatula, hairbrush, ice cream scoop, etc.
- 3. Play the memory verse song and have the entire group sing along. Whoever has the microphone gets to stand in the center of the circle and be the Rock Star.
- 4. When the song is over, pass the microphone to the next person.
- 5. Repeat until everyone has had a chance to be the Rock Star.
