# **CHARACTER TRAIT:**

# INITIATIVE

# **DEFINITION:**

Taking wise action without being told

### **MEMORY VERSE:**

"In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father." MATTHEW 5:16 NLT

### **FINISH LINE:**

Worship God and celebrate His faithfulness

# **READ**: NEHEMIAH 6:15-16; 8:1-3, 8-12; 9:1-6

### WHAT DOES IT SAY?

### (OBSERVATION)

- How many days did it take Nehemiah and the Israelites to finish the wall? (Only 52 days!)
- 2. Who helped them? How did this make their enemies feel? (God helped them. This made their enemies frightened.)
- 3. From Nehemiah 8, Who was Ezra and what did he do? (He was a priest and a scribe who read and explained God's Word to all the people.)
- 4. Look at Nehemiah 9:3. Days after the Israelites heard God's law, what did they do? (They read more of God's Word, confessed their sins, and continued to worship God.)
- 5. Reread Nehemiah 9:6. What amazing things did they praise God for? (God is the one and only God. He made everything and is in control of everything.)

### WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

### (INTERPRETATION)

- How did the people respond to Ezra's words? (They listened and worshiped God.)
- 2. Look at Nehemiah 8:10 & 12. Why did Nehemiah tell the people to go and have a big party? What reasons did they have to celebrate? (God protected them from their enemies and helped them finish the wall. They had heard God's words and understood. God proved He is faithful and that is always worth celebrating.)
- 3. The Israelites thanked God for His faithfulness throughout Israel's history. What had God done for them? (He rescued them from Egypt, parted the Red Sea, protected them in the wilderness, defeated enemies, gave them a kingdom, kept His promises, showed them mercy, etc.)

## WHY DOES IT MATTER?

### (APPLICATION)

- 1. What are some ways God has shown His faithfulness in your life? What are creative ways you can worship God and celebrate God's faithfulness? (Ideas: sing/dance to worship music, draw a picture for Him, write a poem/song for Him, enjoy time in His creation, tell stories about Him to others, etc.)
- 2. What is one simple way you can show initiative today? In what ways can you step up, speak out, stand firm, or celebrate God this week?
