

# PRESCHOOL ACTIVITY GUIDE

**TODAY'S STORY:** The Holy Spirit Comes

**TEACHING TRUTH:** The Holy Spirit is our Helper

## ACTIVITY 1: STORY REVIEW – The Holy Spirit comes

**SUPPLIES:** Balloon

1. Find a space to do this activity outside or in a large open room indoors.
2. Remind your child that when Jesus left, He promised to send the Holy Spirit to be their Helper. When the Holy Spirit came, Jesus' disciples heard and felt a wind in their room.
3. Blow up a balloon, but do not tie it. Release the balloon so that it blows around the room.
4. Tell your child that just like you felt and heard the wind from the balloon, Jesus' friends felt and heard the Holy Spirit blowing like the wind when He came.
5. Blow up the balloon and release a few more times, so your child can enjoy watching it fly around the room.

## ACTIVITY 2: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW – The Holy Spirit is our Helper

**SUPPLIES:** Construction paper, tissue paper, stickers, markers, scissors, hole punch, stapler or tape, string

1. Help your child create a windsock. Start by having your child decorate a piece of construction paper with stickers, crayons, and anything else she wants.
2. Cut tissue paper into strips. Help your child tape the tissue paper to the back of the construction paper, along one of the long edges.
3. Roll the paper into a tube so the short sides come together and overlap. Make sure the decorated side faces outward. Staple and/or tape the sides together.
4. Punch two holes into the end of the tube without the streamers.
5. Tie the ends of the string to the holes so that you can hang it outside and let it catch the wind.
6. Remind your child that the Holy Spirit first came like a wind. Now He lives inside everyone who believes in Jesus as their Helper.

## ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW – Psalm 107:1 – Rockstar

**SUPPLIES:** Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), something to use as a microphone

1. Sit in a circle on the floor.
2. Give one person a fake microphone. You could use a pen, spatula, hairbrush, ice cream scoop, etc.
3. Play the memory verse song and have the entire group sing along. Whoever has the microphone gets to stand in the center of the circle and be the Rock Star.
4. When the song is over, pass the microphone to the next person.
5. Repeat until everyone has had a chance to be the Rock Star.
