THIS WEEK'S STORY:

The Red Sea

UNIT: Moses and Joshua

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

JOSHUA 1:9

TEACHING TRUTH:

God protects His children

READ: Exodus 14

OPTIONAL: "God Makes a Way" (pages 92-99) in [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Where was God leading the Israelites? (*He was leading them out of Egypt and to a land He promised to give them.*)
2. Why were the Israelites afraid? (*Because Pharaoh and his army were chasing after them.*)
3. Did God protect His children? (Yes.) What did God do so the Israelites could escape from Pharaoh? (*He gave Moses power to part the Red Sea so the Israelites could walk across on dry ground.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. How did God show He was powerful? (*God parted the Red Sea and defeated the Egyptians. It was a miracle, something wonderful only God could do.*)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God protects His children.*)
3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that He protects His children, including you.
