TODAY'S STORY: The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20)

TEACHING TRUTH: God's way is the best way

ACTIVITY 1: STORY REVIEW – Ten Commandment Chant

SUPPLIES: None

- 1. Have everyone sit in a circle.
- 2. Tell them you are going to say a rule and they have to decide if it is one of God's special rules (or Ten Commandments).
- 3. If it is one of God's special rules, tell them to jump up and yell, "YES!"
- 4. If it is NOT one of God's special rules, tell them to cover their eyes and yell, "NO!"
- 5. Go through the list of rules and help everyone decide if it is a special rule or not. (HINT: The rules with the * are part of the Ten Commandments.)

LIST OF RULES:

- 1. I am God. Worship only me.*
- 2. Eat popsicles every day.
- 3. Do not steal other people's things.*
- 4. Honor your father and mother.*
- 5. Jump on the bed.
- 6. Pick all your mom's flowers.
- 7. Do not tell lies.*
- 8. Never pick up your toys.
- 9. Use the Lord's name the right way.*
- 10. Never eat vegetables.
- 11. Keep the Lord's Day holy.*
- 12. Do not kill.*

ACTIVITY 2: TEACHING TRUTH REVIEW – God's way is the best way

SUPPLIES: None

- 1. Play follow the leader to help review this week's Teaching Truth: God's way is the best way.
- 2. Choose a leader and let them lead everyone through your house or yard doing fun things along the way such as hopping, skipping, walking in a zigzag, walking like a duck, etc.
- 3. Every once in a while, as you are playing, have everyone shout, "God's way is the best way!"

ACTIVITY 3: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW – Jeremiah 33:3 – Musical Shapes

SUPPLIES: Memory verse song (on the Preschool Kids Kit page), paper (one piece per person), markers/crayons

- 1. If you have different colors of paper, draw different shapes on each page with a black marker or cut them into shapes. If you only have white paper, draw different shapes on each page using different colors.
- 2. Make a circle on the floor with all the pieces of paper and have each person stand on one page.
- 3. Explain that they are going to sing along with the song and walk on the pages as the music plays.
- 4. When the song is at the end of the verse, stop the song. Each person should be standing on one page.
- 5. Call out a color. Whoever is standing on that color will shout out the verse address (Jeremiah 33:3).
- 6. Repeat until all colors have been called. If you want to keep practicing, continue playing the song and call out different shapes when you stop the music.
