

CHARACTER TRAIT: TRUSTWORTHINESS

FINISH LINE: God is trustworthy and always keeps His promises

SCRIPTURE: Numbers 13-14

ACTIVITY 1: MEMORY VERSE GAME

SUPPLIES: 10-15 index cards or pieces of paper, a pen or marker

SET UP: Write 2-3 words from this month's memory verse, Hebrews 10:23, on each index card. Hide the cards around the room before starting the game.

DIRECTIONS: Tell your kids that the words to this month's memory verse are hidden all around the room, like hidden treasure. Challenge them to see how quickly they can find the cards. Once they have found them, bring them together and unscramble them. After you have laid them out in order, read the verse all together. You can keep practicing by scrambling the words a few times and see if they can put the verse in order faster each time! Save these cards and use them to practice all month long.

MEMORY VERSE: "Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep His promise." Hebrews 10:23

ACTIVITY 2: LESSON REVIEW

SUPPLIES: God's promises page (Found on this week's Elementary Kids Kit), Bible, and writing utensil

DIRECTIONS: Pull up the list of promises God has made to us, which can be found on this week's Elementary Kids Kit. Read through the list of promises together. Then have each person choose one of the promises that they want to remember. Next, pull out a Bible and look up the scripture reference that goes with the promise and read the verse. Finally, grab a sticky note or piece of paper and write down the promise and verse placing it in a spot where you can see it every day. This may be on your bathroom mirror, refrigerator, or in the car. Whenever you see it, let it remind you all week long that God is trustworthy and always keeps His promises.

EXTRA CHALLENGE: Memorize the verse you chose to help you remember that promise of God this week.
