

PRESCHOOL DISCUSSION GUIDE

THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Sin

UNIT: The Beginning

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

GENESIS 1:1

TEACHING TRUTH:

Sin separates us from God

READ: Genesis 3:1- 13

OPTIONAL: "The Terrible Lie" (pages 28--36) from [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. What was the first sin? (*Adam and Eve ate the fruit from the tree that God told them not to eat.*)
2. Who lied to Adam and Eve and tricked them into disobeying God? (*Satan did, disguised as a snake.*)
3. What was the consequence of Adam and Eve's sin? (*They had to leave their home in the garden, and their sin separated them from God.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Why did Adam and Eve have to leave God's perfect garden? (*Because they had sinned, and their sin meant they could not be with God anymore.*)
2. What is sin? (*Anything we think, say, or do that is not pleasing to God*)
3. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: Sin separates us from God.*)
4. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that even though our sin separates us from God, He made a plan to bring us back to Him through Jesus.
