Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet

UNIT: Serving Others

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind... and love your neighbor as yourself."

MATTHEW 22:37 & 39

TEACHING TRUTH:

Jesus is the greatest example of serving others

READ: JOHN 13:1-17

OPTIONAL: "The Servant King" (pages 286-292) from [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Why was the meal Jesus was sharing with His disciples so special? *(It was the last meal He would have with them before He died on the cross for our sins.)*
2. How did Jesus serve His disciples? *(He washed their feet for them.)*
3. After Jesus washed their feet, what did He tell His disciples to do? *(Jesus told them to follow His example and serve each other.)*

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. What are some ways we can follow Jesus' example and serve the people around us? *(Examples: Helping them clean up a mess, sharing our toys with them, doing extra chores, etc.)*
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? *(Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth. Jesus is the greatest example of serving others.)*
3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that Jesus is the greatest example of serving others.
